## Father's Message

Last week, Archbishop ListECKI asked the parishes in the Archdiocese to relook at their safety protocols for Covid. The Archbishop issued no mandate as of now to wear masks but asks us all to think about it. What the Archbishop did ask, was that each parish has safe seating and masking areas for those who feel that is their best way to stay safe. You will notice this weekend that we will have seating that is social distanced. If the seating is marked off for social distance, a mask must be worn in those seats.

Everyone must make their own decisions. We know all personal situations vary, and we know we cannot make a tailor made plan for all. We want everyone to feel safe, welcome, and comfortable worshipping. Comfort for some does not include masks, but if you can do it for an hour, it would help.

As always, please refrain from coming to Mass if you feel sick. Mass attendance is excused for the ill and always has been. If you have been exposed at work or school to known Covid cases, it protects your brothers and sisters to stay home for a week. There are Masses on TV and EWTN and your obligation for Mass is dispensed. We do not want you to get too comfortable at home, however. It is always best to be here worshipping together, so let us stay safe and take care of each other.

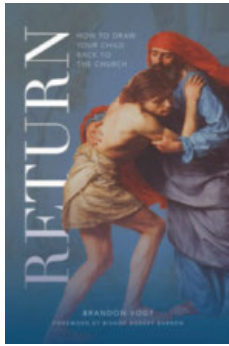

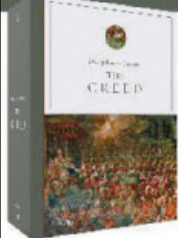

**THE CREED**  
 Coming to St. John the Baptist - January 2022



Recent decades have witnessed a surge of the religiously unaffiliated, especially among young people. Many former believers have simply turned their backs on Christianity and no longer accept its teachings. But what are those teachings? In *The Creed*, a new film series blending documentary conversations and dynamic talks, Bishop Robert Barron guides viewers into the depths of the Nicene Creed, a fourth-century statement of faith that has profoundly influenced Christian spirituality, theology, and liturgy in both the East and West. Explore the meaning of "belief" and whether it contradicts reason; the creative love of God the Father; the shocking mystery of his Son's Incarnation, and the great drama of his Crucifixion and Resurrection; the life-giving power of the *Spiritus Sanctus*, or "holy breath," shared between them; and the mystical reality of the Church, which calls all of humanity out of the world of sin to receive forgiveness and participate in Christ's divinity—not only in the next world but here and now.
