## Father's Message

Last week, Archbishop Listecki asked the parishes in the Archdiocese to relook at their safety protocols for Covid. The Archbishop issued no mandate as of now to wear masks but asks us all to think about it. What the Archbishop did ask, was that



each parish has safe seating and masking areas for those who feel that is their best way to stay safe. You will notice this weekend that we will have seating that is social distanced. If the seating is marked off for social distance, a mask must be worn in those seats.

Everyone must make their own decisions. We know all personal situations vary, and we know we cannot make a tailor made plan for all. We want everyone to feel safe, welcome, and comfortable worshiping. Comfort for some does not include masks, but if you can do it for an hour, it would help.

As always, please refrain from coming to Mass if you feel sick. Mass attendance is excused for the ill and always has been. If you have been exposed at work or school to known Covid cases, it protects your brothers and sisters to stay home for a week. There are Masses on TV and EWTN and your obligation for Mass is dispensed. We do not want you to get too comfortable at home, however. It is always best to be here worshiping together, so let us stay safe and take care of each other.


