

Father's Message

This weekend, St. Paul, in his first letter to the Corinthians, tells each of us how indispensable we are to each other in the life of the Church. Not all of us have the same gifts, and that should not make us feel inadequate. I used to waste a lot of time



wishing I could do this or that as well as the other person can. I think we can depress ourselves thinking others are so much more talented and being mildly jealous of them. You are talented in the way God wants you to be. Have you used or even found your talents? Many people have found and used talents they have from the hardships or sorrows they had in life. God has given them great empathy and they now minister to others in similar situations. You discover talents by trying things, and you do it with other people. I got involved in my home parish more than 20 years ago by doing things with others. Things I never would have done on my own. You make new friends, and discover things about yourself that God wants you to discover.

In that same way, and I hate to have to say this again, but the devil has gifted some with the ability to scam others. People from an area code in southern Pennsylvania are contacting you and asking for money or gift cards in my name. They text or email using my name preying on good hearted people. It must be working or they would not do it. Please, never fall for this. I will never email or text you looking for money. Likewise, the IRS will never email you looking for gift cards to pay your tax debts. I thought these scams would go away because people have been alerted. I worry about what comes next or a new generation of scams.

We do have a capital campaign coming. My guess is we will use snail mail or in Church solicitation. Be assured, we will not be asking for gift cards. God bless!



SETON'S FOCUS ON SAINTS

SAINT DOMINIC

Saint Dominic was born in 1170 near the town of Osma, in Spain. Before his birth, Dominic's mother had a vision of a dog leaping from her womb carrying a flaming torch, which, according to her, "seemed to set the Earth on fire." At the age of 14, Dominic went to Osma to be educated. However, at this time, there was a great famine in Spain, causing



Dominic to sell his possessions to help feed the hungry. Later in his life, Dominic founded the Dominican order, also known as the Order of Preachers. Inspired by the lifestyle of the early Christians as described in the Acts of the Apostles, the Dominican order tried to educate through informed preaching. Dominic is the patron saint of the Dominican order, the falsely accused, and astronomers. Dominic died on August 6, 1221, and he was canonized on July 3, 1234. His feast day is August 8th.
