

### Father's Message

Today we have a gospel that really resembles the life we seem to live today in politics. Jesus reads a gospel passage to his kinfolk in Nazareth last week. Today the message is continued to its end. Jesus is in His home town. The people say what a



nice boy! Then it becomes wait a minute...is this not the carpenter's son? He isn't doing great things like He did in the other city. Jesus reads their hearts and reminds them of their history. During the time of Elijah, God sent him to a gentile woman and during the time of Elisha the prophet, He cured Naaman the Syrian and no one else.

When the people heard this, they did not want to hear it, even if it was the truth. What was the normal human reaction? They became furious. The word fury was used in the gospel to describe them. Jesus did not lie to them, He told them the truth but the truth made them furious. The people led Him up the hill to throw Him off the cliff. Thankfully it was not His time and He escaped . . .it was a different hill He would be led to — people becoming furious with the other. Sounds like Washington a little bit. People tend to shoot first and ask questions later. We have not changed much in many ways. How do we handle the truth? Will we learn what we need to learn to find the truth? Will we be open to the truth if it is presented but it goes against our story line? Only Jesus can help us do that. Only Jesus can break through our human pride. Let us pray for truth in society.

### PARENTS OF YOUNG CHILDREN


