

FATHER'S MESSAGE

It is easy to fall away from our Lenten resolve. We may have miscalculated that resolve. For those who have not, I will suggest something. It is on You Tube and it is The Bible in a Year podcast by Fr. Mike Schmitz. It has been quite a long time since



I took a deep dive into Scripture. Quite frankly, I do not even remember if I read the entire Bible. One thing I do know is this. I have forgotten more about the Bible than I know. I know the books I have not only read but studied. Going through the podcast, I often think to myself I do not remember this part. Admittedly, there is much redundancy in scripture and sometimes I get a little "glassy eyed" listening to it.

Fr. Mike reads a chapter from two books and does a Psalms or Proverbs chapter. It is not hard work. It takes a little over 20 minutes a day. I try to write down the important part of the days teaching. He follows up with an explanation every day. It is so important to understand the Old Testament to understand what God is doing for us. If you want that great relationship with God, it is good to know how God worked in the past. Why was there so much violence, and why did God appear so callous and judgmental to the people He chose? Fr. Mike gives great lessons and it helps us understand the Old Testament image of God. It helps us understand that now, Jesus is the image of the invisible God. Jesus says, if you have seen me, you have seen the Father. It is hard to listen to some of the judgement and violence, but God is working something wonderful in the ancient world and there is a reason. The reason is knowable.

FAST & ABSTINENCE GUIDELINES

Customarily, fasting requires that a person take only one meal a day, but current Church discipline permits one to take a main meal and two lesser meals which together do not equal the main meal. All persons who have reached their 14th birthday are bound by the law of abstinence. All adults are bound by the law of fast from their 18th to their 60th year. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat and meat products as well as days of fast. The other Fridays of Lent remain days of abstinence from meat and meat products. 
