

Last weekend, you may have noticed, if you go to confessions at Holy Name, that the confessionals now have a glass window in them. We will be doing the same at St. Clement. The place we do confessions at St. Dominic is already in back in a room



enclosed by glass. There are not many places left that have the old fashioned confessional and a penitent room separated by a wall. Most new places have a confessional where there is a glass door. I felt it was time to do that because it protects everyone involved. The school children have confession up front, in front of everyone. Religious education will be the same way. There will be no confessions any more that cannot be witnessed, that are out of sight.

This is mostly because as priests - it is not good to be alone with kids. I wish it was not this way, but the times and the past sins of the clergy require this move. If your children come to confessions, please have them in your view. I am sorry this is necessary but it would also have kept several priests from being charged, that were found innocent later, after much anguish. Happy Lent!


