

FATHER'S MESSAGE

The prodigal son is one of the more famous stories Jesus speaks about in scripture. While scripture certainly does not address every issue or scenario we go through in our lives, there is certainly enough teachings and verses we hear where we can



make a pretty educated guess as to what Jesus would say about any subject imaginable. So why do we struggle so mightily? The short answer is we do not want to think Jesus would speak against what I believe or how I feel. In actuality, the love of God is so contradictory to how we feel sometimes that it does not make human sense. The prodigal son is very much like that. There are so many families that are estranged from each other in many ways. The one boy has done everything right and has respected his parents his whole life.

Then, the wild and disrespectful brother makes a fool of the family, steals its wealth, and disappears. He finally returns and asks forgiveness. He requests no special place again but he gets elevated back to his spot within the family by a forgiving father. Of course the brother who has done nothing wrong is furious. That is the human reaction to this mercy. This parable can work in almost every human relationship we have that has become wounded. The father in the parable is God and it shows divine forgiveness. It is pretty easy to discern then what our response should be to any human relationship we have that has become problematic. Interpretation of scripture is not hard sometimes, it is just hard to do and difficult to want to follow. Happy Lent!




