

Embracing the cross is doing all the things our gospels in Lent were teaching. Jesus defeated temptations, will we? Can we put away the human desire for glory as was shown at the transfiguration? Will we ignore God and pursue earthly desires? Will we put down others to make ourselves look good? All these were addressed by Jesus the past four weeks. It is a cross to deny all these human temptations. Happy Lent!



APRIL OUTREACH CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES TO BENEFIT HAITI



Haiti entered 2022 facing a multitude of dangerous, daunting challenges.

Already tormented by a year which included another major earthquake (and followed immediately by a tropical storm that nearly reached hurricane-like strength), the assassination of President Jovenel Moise, a worsening security situation and the reality of the COVID-19 pandemic, Haiti entered 2022 facing formidable political, economic, and social challenges.

Catholic Relief Services (CRS) began working in Haiti in 1954 after Hurricane Hazel devastated the country and killed about 1,000 people. High population density, severe deforestation, and decaying infrastructure make Haiti particularly vulnerable to the effects of natural disasters such as hurricanes, earthquakes, and floods.

CRS Haiti continues its long-standing commitment to helping the Haitian people in many aspects of their lives, including sustainable development efforts after the 2010 earthquake. In Haiti, CRS responds to [emergencies](#), provides [agriculture](#) assistance, supports [education](#) and works to enhance the [health care system](#) throughout the country.

With a broad network of local and church partners and deep roots in the communities where we work, CRS is uniquely positioned to assist with community capacity building. We strengthen local organizations, support grassroots advocacy, and provide strategic guidance that leads to sustainable change. In Haiti CRS works closely with the Church and all 10 dioceses, as well as the Church education network (CEEC).

COMPROMISO DE ABRIL:

SERVICIOS DE ALIVIO CATÓLICO EN BENEFICIO DE HAITÍ

Haití entró en 2022 enfrentando una multitud de desafíos peligrosos y de enormes proporciones. Ya atormentado por un año que incluyó otro gran terremoto (y seguido inmediatamente por una tormenta tropical que casi alcanzó la fuerza de un huracán), el asesinato del presidente Jovenel Moise, el empeoramiento de la situación de seguridad y la realidad de la pandemia de COVID-19, Haití entró el 2022 enfrentando tremendos desafíos políticos, económicos y sociales.

Catholic Relief Services (CRS) comenzó a trabajar en Haití en 1954 después de que el huracán Hazel devastara el país y matara a unas 1000 personas. La alta densidad de población, la deforestación severa y la infraestructura en deterioro hacen que Haití sea particularmente vulnerable a los efectos de los desastres naturales como huracanes, terremotos e inundaciones.

CRS Haití continúa con su compromiso de ayudar al pueblo haitiano en muchos aspectos de sus vidas, incluidos los esfuerzos de desarrollo sostenible después del terremoto de 2010. En Haití, CRS responde a emergencias, brinda asistencia agrícola, apoya la educación y trabaja para mejorar el sistema de atención médica en todo el país.

Con una amplia red de socios locales, eclesiásticos y con profundas raíces en las comunidades donde trabajamos, CRS está en una posición única para ayudar con el desarrollo de capacidades comunitarias. Fortalecemos las organizaciones locales, apoyamos la defensa de base y brindamos orientación estratégica que conduce a un cambio sostenible. En Haití, CRS trabaja en estrecha colaboración con la iglesia y las 10 diócesis, así como con la red de educación de la iglesia (CEEC).
