

SOCIAL DISTANCE AND MASKING

Sheboygan County Covid cases are currently labeled as LOW. As such, beginning with Palm Sunday, our Sheboygan North Parishes will make changes to "Social Distancing Sections" in our churches. FATHER'S MESSAGE

With the diminished level of COVID, we are eliminating some social distancing measures in the Church because it is necessary to have the seats available. Masks are voluntary and can provide some help. We will do what we can to provide for those who need some distance, ask an



usher. There is still some seating at St. Dominic's that can provide a safe distance to worship. We are in need of all those who use to worship to come back to us, so please invite your neighbors. It has been difficult for you, and all of us, as we miss those who have been away. Please help make us whole by returning and staying.

We enter the Holiest week of the year, thus Holy Week. We listen to the passion of the Christ this triumphant Sunday. It so represents human nature. On Palm Sunday we see Jesus welcomed as a King in Jerusalem, and then the "fickle" human being in us takes over, and in the span of four days we are selling Jesus for silver and yelling for the King to be crucified. That is so us, in so many ways, as human beings. We are discontinuous. Passion Sunday we hear the text from two gospels. Our processional gospel of Jesus' triumphant entry to Jerusalem, to the passion which helps us reflect on our humanness as we enter into the reality of Good Friday. There is no Easter without Good Friday...let us own it!


