NEW DIRECTOR OF YOUTH MINISTRY

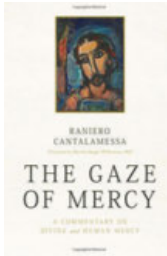

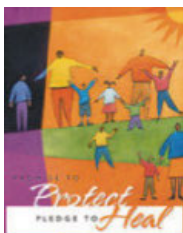
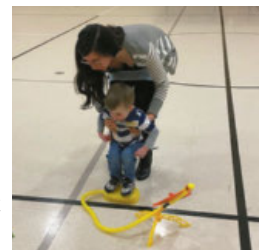

SETON SAINT OF THE MONTH

ST. TERESA OF CALCUTTA

St. Teresa of Calcutta, or more commonly known as Mother Teresa, was born in Skopje, Macedonia. Her father passed away when she was just 8 years old, however with her family being strong in faith her mother taught her the value of caring for the sick and the poor. Because of this she dedicated her life to serving the sick and the poor.



Mother Teresa's first miracle was healing a Native woman with a lump growing on her abdomen. The woman, Monica Besra, was severely sick and prayed in front of a picture of Mother Teresa that had light emanating from it and, in return, she was cured.

Her second miracle was curing a man who had brain abscesses. The man was near death and slipped into a coma. A priest gave his wife a relic of Mother Teresa when they first married. She placed the relic on her husband's head where the abscesses were and prayed. Before he was sent to surgery he woke up and made a complete recovery.

Mother Teresa was canonized in the Vatican in front of 120,000 people on September 4, 2016.
