FATHER'S MESSAGE

We celebrate one of our Easter Sacraments this weekend with the reception of First Communion. So, congratulations, again, to all the young people who have worked so hard preparing their hearts and minds for this great event. Baptism is a non-renewable event. But the Eucharist is just as important the second, fifth, or five-thousandth time. God offers us this gift repeatedly, so we do not want to say no thanks. If you offer a gift to someone, you do not want to hear, no thanks. You offer gifts out of love, and want people to enjoy them. God is the same way! If God can be saddened, and there is always a theological debate on that, it would be because of our rejection of His gifts.

I also want to talk about anointing of the sick. I will probably write more thoroughly on this later. Do not wait until the last minute to have a loved one anointed. If you are putting someone in hospice, anoint them then. Do not wait. It is almost assured that they will pass on the weekend when the offices are not open or when a priest is unreachable because of Masses, weddings, baptisms, or whatever is going on. We may also be gone. I can think of several times in the last month where we got last minute calls on the answering machine for someone dying. Occasionally they pass away, before we can get to them, which is a horrible feeling. If your parents are in a different town, make sure to call the Church much sooner than later. Don't think an anointing needs to be done right before death. God does not expect us to know when we are called home so we must always be ready.

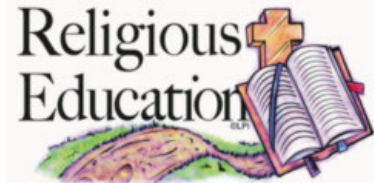

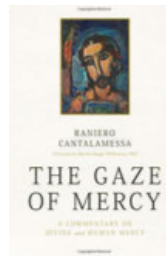

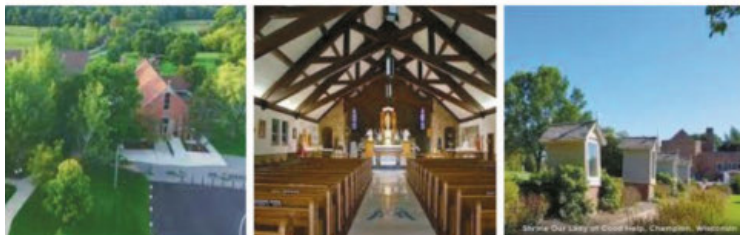
