

FATHER'S MESSAGE

We get some pretty interesting readings during the Easter Season. Included in these are the book of Revelation. Revelation is the most controversial or most difficult to interpret of all scripture because of the intense symbolism of the text. It can be frightening to read also because of all the



symbolism which the human writer had no idea of how to explain what he was witnessing. In God's way, I think it may be to keep a little mystery in life. Some is easily interpreted. We get a vision of the new Jerusalem today. It is a vision of the four walls and three gates on each side representing the twelve tribes of Israel. The twelve Apostles are represented by the foundation, or twelve levels of the base. Old Testament and New Testament will not be separated from each other in eternity. They are both integral and are a unity of our faith life.

The last thing Jesus taught before the Last Supper, or the end of His public ministry, in John's gospel is the symbol of light. He is the light of the world. The book of Revelation shows a literal light today. God is intense light, and so is Jesus. The Apostle Paul was called by Jesus in an explosion of light that blinded him. In the Transfiguration of the Lord, Jesus is portrayed as intense light in His glorified Body. In the book of the Exodus, whenever Moses appeared before God, his face became so full of light he had to cover it in front of the Israelites. There is no need of the sun in the heavenly realm, because God is the light, and Jesus the lamp in this heavenly picture. This will be something to behold. Looking forward to it!


