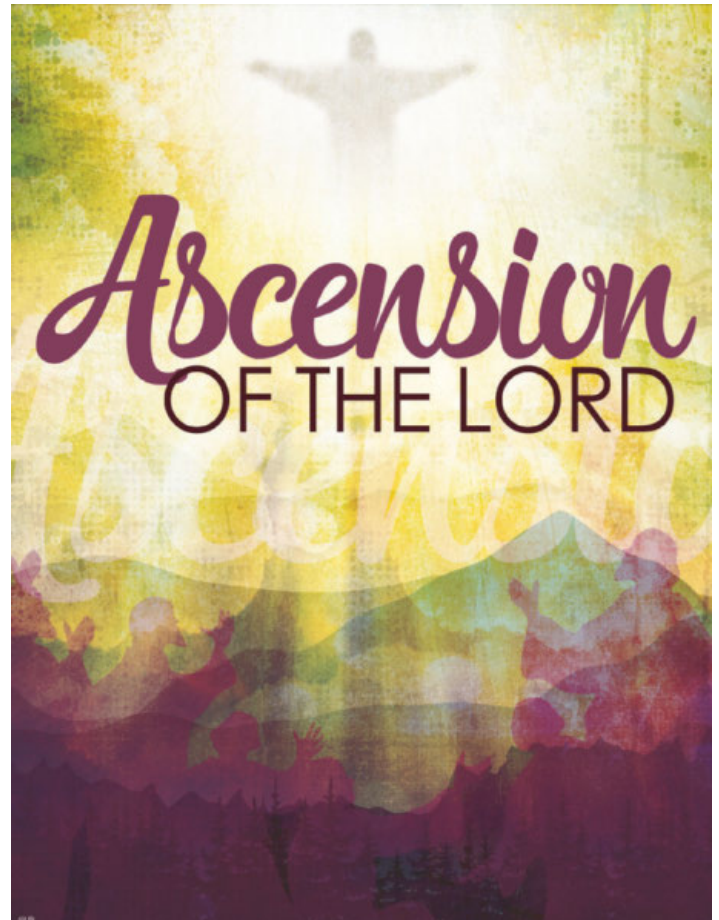

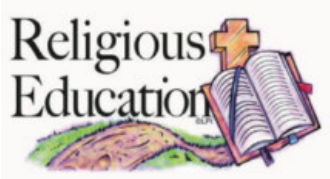

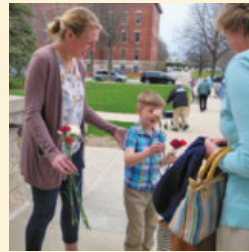

Students can sign up for one to three days or all four days. Volunteers can serve any number of hours fitting into their schedule. We prefer full days for ease of scheduling but do not require full weeks. We are looking for adults who can be available on a daily and/or weekly basis as each job site must always have two adults.

Adults typically supervise, and most choose to work alongside, the students. Adults monitor students for safety concerns and thoroughness etc. Our typical jobs are yard work such as windows, raking, mulching, weeding, cleaning/organizing at our discretion and possibly painting or staining depending on size of job and number of volunteers. Adults must complete a background check along with Safe Environment training through the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. If you are not Safe Environment trained, there will be a training at Blessed Trinity prior to June 20th.
