

## FATHER'S MESSAGE

Every year we remember the greatest moments in the life of Christ, as these moments remember our own salvation history. We are close to finishing our Easter Season and this weekend, as we remember Jesus leaving for good. The Ascension is so important for us because, as we have found



out, Jesus has left the Apostle's and all humanity without His special presence in their everyday life. Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to be our guide until He returns one day. It is really a feast of spirituality. Jesus may be gone physically, but He is present in our lives in a unique way that requires us to think and become open to the spiritual side of our being. Students can sign up for one to three days or all four days. Volunteers can serve any number of hours fitting into their schedule. We prefer full days for ease of scheduling but do not require full

weeks. We are looking for adults who can be available on a daily and/or weekly basis as each job site must always have two adults. Adults typically supervise, and most choose to work alongside, the students. Adults monitor students for safety concerns and thoroughness etc. Our typical jobs are yard work such as windows, raking, mulching, weeding, cleaning/organizing at our discretion and possibly painting or staining depending on size of job and number of volunteers. Adults must complete a background check along with Safe Environment training through the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. If you are not Safe Environment trained, there will be a training at Blessed Trinity prior to June 20th.
