

#### From the Pastor

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, a day of fasting and abstinence. If you are 14 years old and older, then you don't eat meat. If you are between 18 and 59, then you fast, which means no food between meals, and only one meal. You may eat a small portion to maintain health.

Our Masses on Ash Wednesday are at 6:00 a.m., 12:10 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. At 8:00 a.m. there will be a Communion Service with distribution of ashes. Distribution of ashes for the children will take place in the classrooms. Keep in mind, there is a change this year with how you will be marked with ashes. They will be sprinkled on the top of your head instead of a sign of the cross on your forehead. During Lent we will have the Way of the Cross on Friday evenings at 7 o'clock.

The first Mass on weekdays during Lent used to move up15 minutes for a start time at 6:15, but this year the first Mass will stay at 6:30 a.m.

We wish everyone a Happy Valentine's Day today, the 14<sup>th</sup> of February. It can be a good reminder for us to express our love and affection for our spouse, and loved ones.

Mark your calendars for the opening of the Sr. Ethelbert Center. This will take place next weekend, 20 and 21 February. After each Mass the center will be open for you to come through and see all that has been done in the museum area. It's quite remarkable. Because of the COVID restrictions, there will not be refreshments, but you are encouraged to come and see the place. The idea for now is to not hang around and visit. That will happen as we move through this pandemic. From what I've read, Sr. Ethelbert and Mr. J.H. Griffin were the giants of our Teutopolis School System that we take for granted today. J. H. Griffin has the gym named after him on the west side of town, and Sr. Ethelbert has this area named after her on the east side.

In last week's bulletin I mentioned our varsity boys entering the Apollo Conference with a victory over Mt Zion. I feel I would be remiss if I failed to mention that our Lady Shoes, who this week were victorious over both teams from Effingham! On Monday we beat Effingham, and the Ladies were victorious against St. Anthony's Bulldogs on Tuesday with a convincing score of 70 to 27! Congratulations, Lady Shoes!

#### Dear Friends in the Lord,

The season of Lent begins this year on Ash Wednesday, February 17, 2021 and ends just prior to the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 1, 2021, when the Paschal Triduum begins. Lent is the principal penitential season in the Church year. All the Christian faithful are urged to develop and maintain a voluntary program of self-denial (in addition to the Lenten regulations which follow), serious prayer and the performing of deeds of charity and mercy, including the giving of alms.

#### **LENTEN REGULATIONS –**

- 1. ABSTINENCE Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. FAST Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.

May this holy season be a time of spiritual renewal for each of us!


