From the Pastor

Everyone should serve on the parish council at least once. A person, leaving the council after 3 years of service, made this comment, and the rationale was that through serving on the council a person learns a good deal of all that is involved with the workings of the parish. We say thank you to three parishioners, who are finishing their commitment: Scott Brumleve, Jerry Runde, and Tom Uthell. I'm sure they would agree with the statement about serving on the council and learning a great deal. Each of them has served faithfully, and we thank them. As of this particular time, I don't know who their replacements are, whom the parish voted for. The slate had very good candidates, and choosing would be difficult. I'm sure the Holy Spirit guided our parishioners for the best candidate in this particular time. Scott, Jerry and Tom – thank you from all the parishioners for your service.

This weekend is our opening of the Sr. Ethelbert Center, and you are invited to walk through the area after each of our Masses. This is another Covid Casualty in the sense of people not able to rent it because of the limits and restrictions of the numbers of people allowed in one space. There were several people wishing to rent it for Christmas parties for their families, but the numbers didn't work. There will come a time when it will be used a great deal, I'm sure.

I know I mentioned this before, but I want to stress my gratitude to you for continuing to support your church during this time. I know some don't feel safe or comfortable to come to worship on a weekend, but that doesn't stop them from sending in their envelope of financial support, or they give on line or direct deposit. Thank you. And I am grateful to many of you for wearing your mask when you come to Mass. I join many of you in not liking to wear it, but that's not the question – whether we like it or not. Health experts encourage us to wear the mask, wash our hands frequently, and keep a safe distance between ourselves and others. People from other parishes have told me they are glad to come to St. Francis for Mass because so many people wear the mask here. Our children wear a mask all day at school. Medical people wear a mask all day in their jobs. The time we are encouraged to wear a mask is minimal. It's not asking a great deal.

Below is what our Pope Francis has written about fasting during Lent. It's more than giving up food!

At the 10:30 Mass today we are having the Rite of Sending for two catechumens, who have been meeting with the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). Anne Marie Brummer is our leader of the RCIA, and she has been "forming" a mother and her daughter in the Catholic faith: Tracy and Chasity Mayhaus. They have one sponsor, who is Judy Childress. They will be "sent" during the 10:30 Mass today, and they will meet others at 2:30 at the cathedral in Springfield for the celebration of their Election. We congratulate them and pledge them our support as a parish as they, and we, move towards Easter.

Fast from complaints......contemplate simplicity.

Fast from grudges.....and be reconciled.

Fast from words......and be silent and listen.

There is a great deal of wisdom in what our holy father advises us to work on this Lent – fasting.
