

From the Pastor

Reminder: I announced last week that there will NOT be a 6:30 a.m. Mass on Wednesday, 10 March. That's this Wednesday. I know there will still be people walking up to the church doors Wednesday morning looking for Mass. Please spread the word. I doubt there will be Mass locally on that Wednesday morning since the priests are participating in meetings with the bishop on 9 and 10 March in Springfield. Our bishop has sent out an agenda for our meetings. Looks like the two topics: our evangelization-focused communications and related formation efforts and strategies, progress to date, plans for the future; and secondly: a brainstorm discussion for post Covid 'return to normal.' We are all ready for a return to normal. The attendance at the 6:30 Mass this Lent has been very high, and I know that's related to other parishes not having an early Mass. And another reminder is that on this Tuesday evening, 9 March, there will NOT be confessions at 6:15.

There will be the opportunity for confessions on 23 March at 7:00 p.m. We are counting on three priests, but that doesn't mean the priests will be here, does it? We live in hope!

And on 30 March we will have the Chrism Mass at the cathedral in Springfield. Bishop Paprocki will bless and consecrate all the oils that will be used throughout the diocese this year, starting with Easter. It is an impressive liturgy. We celebrate the anniversary of two sacraments: the Eucharist and Holy Order.

The schedule of our Holy Week liturgies can be found in the bulletin.

Our phone system is twenty years old, and some of you have realized difficulty in calling in to the rectory. We are in the process of replacing the phone system, and this change comes at a time when everyone is experiencing some changes with making phone calls. Please note the new phone number for the parish office. The change is effective this week. The 20 year old system was nearly obsolete and could not be maintained. It served us well. Please be patient if it takes us a while to make adjustments to the new system. Thank you.

Next week we will have some news for where we are with the Covid situation and church attendance, especially for the liturgies for Holy Week.
