

From the Pastor

This Tuesday evening at 7 o'clock we will offer an opportunity for you to receive the sacrament of reconciliation. We hope to have 3 priests available at that time. This means there will NOT be confessions at the usual time on Tuesday evening (6:15-6:45).

A year ago we were not allowed to gather for the Eucharist, so we had Communion Services on Saturday afternoons and Sunday mornings on the weekends. People signed up for these since we were limited in the number of people, who could gather. We are going to do something similar for our Sacred Triduum and Easter morning Masses this year.

Since God is good all the time, we are allowed to come together to celebrate the Eucharist this year. And we are grateful for this opportunity! Unlike Christmas Masses with calling in, we will do like we did last year when parishioners stopped in and signed up. Instead of a Communion Service, this year we will have Mass!

I am grateful to all of you for how you dealt with the Masses on Christmas Eve and morning. I checked with the ushers after Mass to see if anyone "bullied" them about getting in for Mass. I was told that no one did, and I was very glad to hear this. Ushers don't need to be put on the spot. And I hope we can be as charitable this Easter as we were for Christmas liturgies.

My hope is that by Palm Sunday, next week, we will know which Masses are full, and which ones, if any, have room for people to worship. There will be pages for Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter morning Masses. Please give your name, # of people including yourself, and a phone #. You can sign up in the vestibule weekdays from 6:00 a.m. till 8:00 p.m. Please note, if you sign up, but don't show up, then you are taking a spot of someone, who would like to be here!

About 90 priests met with our bishop last Tuesday and Wednesday. We are still limited to 25% of capacity. This is more of a requirement of the Public Health Dept. for the State than it is coming from our bishop. He will be communicating changes in the diocesan newspaper, so be sure to check it out when you receive the paper in the mail. Bishop wants confirmations to take place at the cathedral. So that is a major change. This takes effect next year, 2022. Our schedule for confirmations is in place for this year. The dispensation for missing Mass on Sundays and Holy Days goes away soon. And the bishop gave us some guidance on the liturgies for the Sacred Triduum.


