From the Pastor

As we celebrate Memorial Day weekend, there are two opportunities for us to come together and pray. Sunday afternoon at 1:00 there will be a Memorial Service at our cemetery. This is sponsored by the members of our local American Legion Post. And on Monday morning at 9 o'clock, we will have Mass at the cemetery – weather permitting of course. If the weather doesn't cooperate, we will gather in church for Mass. On Memorial Day we pray for all men and women, who have died in the military service of our country.

Last Saturday, 22 May, at 10:00 a.m. Fr. Marc Sheckells, O.F.M. was ordained a priest at St. Peter's Church in Chicago's loop. He served here at St. Francis for a year, and several parishioners went to Chicago for his ordination. He has offered to preside at our Masses next weekend. 




