From the Pastor

As we celebrate Memorial Day weekend, there are two opportunities for us to come together and pray. Sunday afternoon at 1:00 there will be a Memorial Service at our cemetery. This is sponsored by the members of our local American Legion Post. And on Monday morning at 9 o'clock, we will have Mass at the cemetery – weather permitting of course. If the weather doesn't cooperate, we will gather in church for Mass. On Memorial Day we pray for all men and women, who have died in the military service of our country.

Last Saturday, 22 May, at 10:00 a.m. Fr. Marc Sheckells, O.F.M. was ordained a priest at St. Peter's Church in Chicago's loop. He served here at St. Francis for a year, and several parishioners went to Chicago for his ordination. He has offered to preside at our Masses next weekend. He will preside at the 4:30 Mass on Saturday, and he will also preside at the 8:30 and 10:30 Masses on 6 June. St. Francis Parish joins Fr. Marc in giving thanks to God for calling him to serve.

With changes in the COVID restrictions, the priests in the diocese of Springfield are free to gather for their retreat. I will be joining them at King's House Retreat House in Belleville, IL. The retreat starts on Sunday evening, 6 June, and continues until 11:30 on Friday morning June 11th. During the week of retreat, there will be only one weekday Mass (at 6:30) here at St. Francis since Fr. Dat will be here by himself. Two Masses on the week days will continue from the 14 to the 18th of June, and then the following week, starting 21 June I will be on vacation. There will be one Mass each day during the week. Watch the bulletin for which days have only one Mass! When there is a second Mass, it is at 8:00 a.m.
