Happy feast of Corpus Christi! The body and blood of Christ, the Eucharist, is the center of our spiritual lives. Normally we would have a procession after the last Sunday Mass, and we would stop for benedictions along the way. This year we have another Covid Casualty with our celebration of Corpus Christi. We are keeping it simple without a large number of servers and choristers marching together and being in a group – with the gathered parishioners - for the three benedictions. Next year we hopefully will return to what we are accustomed to. Whether we have processions and benedictions is not the point with the celebration of Corpus Christi. In fact, in the parish I grew up in, St. John the Baptist in Joiet, IL, we never had a procession or benediction on Corpus Christi. We did have processions around church on Rogation Days! We celebrate Corpus Christi this weekend and every day!

And we're grateful to Ron Ruholl for arranging the altar and the sound system, which worked fine. And appreciate the work of Dan Williams and his choristers for leading the community in song. 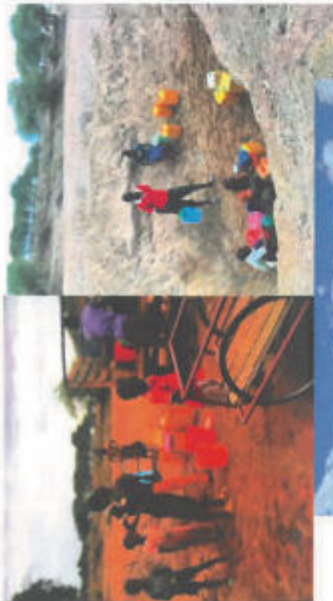

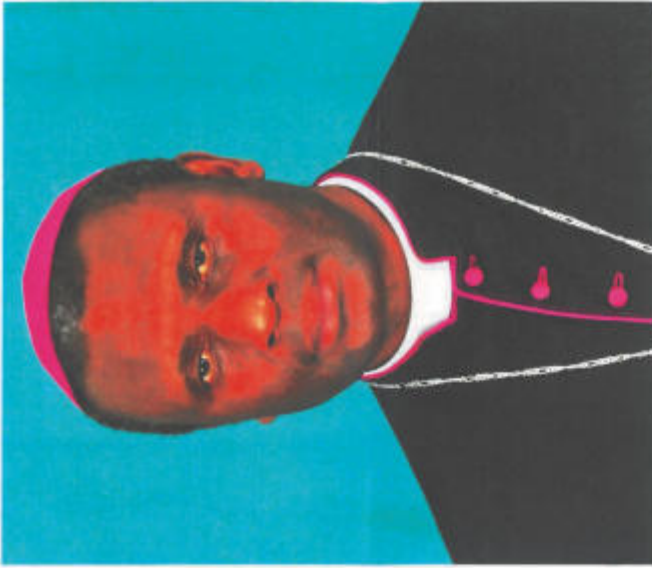

The Diocese of Shinyanga is located in the North West of Tanzania as one of the member Dioceses of the Lake Zone, in Mwanza metropolitan. The Ordinary is The Most Rt. Rev. Liberatus Sangu. The Diocese has 63 Diocesan Priests; 3 Salesians of Don Bosco; 6 SMA Priests; 5 Maryknoll Fathers. They are working in 27 parishes; Sayusayu Pre-Form One Seminary and in one Diocesan Minor Seminary and Mipa Leadership School. The total population in Tanzania is over 50 million. The Diocese of Shinyanga has 3.3 million people and 1,021,000 Catholics which represent 31% of the total population.

"I CAME THAT YOU MIGHT HAVE LIFE AND HAVE IT TO THE FULL..." (John 10:10). The Diocesan Vision is to bring the Good News of Christ, salvation, to all people through the Church and Integral Human Development.

MISSION

Our Mission is to preach the Good News to all. That is, to facilitate a unified participatory and holistic approach in empowering the community to recognize and identify the challenges they face; spiritually and materially support and lead our communities to move forward and solve their problems and anticipate and prepare for the future. To make this mission possible, we focus on deep evangelization, furthering socio-economic development, provision of health services for HIV/AIDS victims, educating orphans/vulnerable children and adolescents; building small Christian communities and supporting the poor and the marginalized. The Diocese of Shinyanga combines nine districts which are Bariadi, Itilima, Kishapu, Maswa, Busega, Meatu, Shinyanga Municipal and Shinyanga rural.

DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES: ORPHANS/CHILDREN OF POOR FAMILIES



Shinyanga is an area which is highly affected by the HIV/AIDS epidemic due to the gold mine activities, the trade road to Rwanda and Burundi, and the open market (minada). Many factors affect the life expectancy of our adults leaving a growing number of orphans. We have planned to give them support for secondary and high school education. Education is their only hope of building a future which will strengthen both our Church and our country. Sponsorship for high school tuition is \$500 a year, but any contribution is most welcome.

ADOLESCENT GIRLS



We also assist in paying for secondary school tuition and fees for those adolescent girls from poor families whose parents might otherwise have to arrange marriage in order to receive a bride's price from the groom's family. Each student needs \$600 a year, but any contribution will enable a young girl an opportunity for a better life.

WIDOWED/SINGLE MOTHERS

We are challenged by the economic instability and social changes caused by HIV/AIDS. The number of single mothers is growing. They are left alone with the responsibility of family care. Victims themselves, they try to find work. Your support will be directed to help them start small scale enterprises, which will enable them to earn money and be able to pay for school fees and tuitions for their children; as well as feed and clothe them. Most of these widowed mothers are young girls with only primary education. The Diocese planned to open a secondary school for girls which will provide the next generation with a better education. We appreciate your support.

HEALTH PROGRAM:

The Diocese of Shinyanga owns three health centers—Bugisi, Buhangija and Ngokolo. They provide medication and pastoral care of the sick. Also, they take care of the victims of HIV/AIDS. The diocese aims to expand the Ngokolo health center by additional building. Financial support is needed to complete the addition. On 11th February 2014, the Catholic Church in Shinyanga launched the Test and Treat Project which will be implemented in Bugisi District in Shinyanga Region in cooperation with the WHO and the Christian Social Services Commission. Your support is encouraged and appreciated.

EDUCATION:

MIPA CATECHETICAL AND LEADERSHIP SCHOOL

The school has the capacity of accommodating 40 catechists. The school has been training catechists from the diocese and outside the diocese. We want to expand our school to accommodate more catechists. The school lacks text books, dormitories, two classrooms, administration block, computers, transport (bicycles), beds and mattresses and a library. Your support in any of these items will be highly appreciated.



SEMINARIANS

The Diocese has 19 major and senior seminarians. They are studying Philosophy and Theology within the country. Your donation will support the Diocese and pay for their tuition and fees. They will become priests in one to seven years.

SHANWA MINOR SEMINARY



The seminary started to be built in 1998. The seminary is lacking the necessary facilities such as: chapel, laboratory, dining hall, staff rooms, learning and teaching materials, books and supplies. The diocese is pleading for support from all friends to assist in the construction of these important structures. With your generous support we will be able to complete this facility and insure priests for the future care of the Church.

DRILL SHALLOW WELLS TO SUPPLY CLEAN AND SAFE WATER

Most rural areas experience severe and acute shortage of water. Women and young people are vulnerable and disadvantaged in the rural areas. They walk long distance to get water in rivers or exposed dams. Sometimes young people and especially women are attacked and raped. Therefore, we need your support to drill some shallow wells around the communities which will provide clean and safe water. One shallow well costs \$6,690.
