From the Pastor

We wish a happy Father's Day to all of our Dads and grandfathers and godfathers, stepfathers, and those who reach out to us with a father's heart. It always seemed to me that fathers just didn't draw as much attention as mothers do. Good old Dad is there, and you can count on him. "Mom" is the center of the family. We see this later in life when a mother of the family dies, who takes her place? Whom do people give information to about what is happening in their family, and which family member knows who is going where and when like Ma used to always know? Having said this, studies show that the faith life and the religious practice of the father are key to the spirituality of the children. Dads, if you want your sons and daughters to mature in their religion, then they need to see you practice your faith. When children see Dad praying the rosary, it means something more than when they see mother praying. If children see Dad going to confession, they remember it. Dad, you have more influence than you sometimes give yourself credit for! This is especially true in terms of passing on your faith to your children. Happy Father's Day!

This Saturday evening we have one Confirmation and 5 Confirmation/First Communions. Bishop Paprocki delegated pastors to administer the sacrament of Confirmation, and this delegation expires on the 30th of June. I will be on vacation the next two weeks – yes, I know, AGAIN?!??? So this is the last time I will be confirming 3rd graders unless the bishop delegates pastors again. In the past few months I have confirmed more people than I ever have. When a priest baptizes an adult, he will also confirm the person, and then the person will receive the Eucharist, completing the sacraments of initiation.

While I am on vacation, your former pastor, Fr. Bob Sieg will preside at the weekend Masses that I would ordinarily have. Please give him a warm welcome.

Please mark your calendar for Wednesday, 30 June. This is a day of Prayer for Life. There will be a Mass at 8 o'clock in the morning and another closing Mass at 7:30 p.m. There will be adoration all day with different parishes responsible for coming and praying. You are welcome to come and pray any time during the day.

On the 7th of June I celebrated my 46th anniversary of Ordination. 1975 was a good year! It is difficult for me to believe I have served the Lord that long. Sort of interesting is the fact that of the 46 years, the first 5 were in St. Louis, and 15 were in the Navy as a chaplain. The rest of the time has been in the Springfield Diocese. And on the 18th of June Fr. Ken Rosswog and I celebrated our birthdays. I couldn't ask for a better birthday buddy. He turned 91, and I turned 74 – we're all children of God!



INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK Do we trust that God will take care of us and has things under control? When life gets difficult, shaky or painful, we may find ourselves wondering what we may have done to deserve this fate. Often, we go to great lengths to explain suffering away, as if it has no purpose and ought not to exist. In an attempt to get God on our side in our battle against suffering, our prayer can mirror a question asked by the disciples: do you not care that we are perishing? As we are asking that question of God, God is asking of us: do you not yet have faith? It is for certain that God does not intentionally inflict pain upon us. God has no sinister plot to test our faith or trip us up. Rather, the unconditional, restorative and rejuvenating power of God's love can bring light out of the greatest darkness and gives hope in the midst of deep despair. We have to be patient and ride out the storm. It is our task to deepen our faith that God will calm the wind and draw meaning out of that which seems senseless.
