From the Pastor

We are having Mass on Labor Day at 9:00 a.m. Let us gather and praise the Lord for the many blessings we enjoy, including having many opportunities in our community for employment. Think of the number of jobs at our big 3 companies like 3Z, Stevens Cabinets, and Siemer Milling, each of which is a 24 hour operation. Let's not forget others like J. B. Esker and Sons! How many contractors/carpenters are there with crews constantly at work building new homes, remodeling, etc.? Our community is blessed, and we are known in the area for having a sound work ethic. That reputation has been earned; it's not a given. May we continue to use the talents and skills the Lord has given us. And may we be grateful to the Lord for making it all happen.

This Saturday is the 20th anniversary of "9-11." We will gather in church at 9:00 am for a memorial service and pray for the men and women, who died on 9/11/01 either in New York City, Washington, D.C. (Pentagon), or in Shanks-ville, Pennsylvania. This "event" marks the deadliest incident for firefighters and law enforcement personnel – 340 firefighters and 172 law enforcement! There are moments in our lives that I call "clock stoppers." We remember where we were, and what we were doing when we first heard.... Pearl Harbor's attack was a clock stopper. The explosion of the Space Shuttle Challenger was another clock stopper. If you are not free to come to church at 9:00 am on 9/11, then please pray that day for all the people, who died 20 years ago on that day.

We are back to offering the sacrament of Penance or Reconciliation on both Tuesday and Thursday evenings. We have confessions from 6:15 to 6:45 on these two evenings each week, along with the usual opportunity from 3:00 to 4:00 on each Saturday afternoon.


