

The choir, under the direction of Dan Williams, did an outstanding job singing the evening Mass. Thank you. Barb Runde and Eric Habing contributed so much, and a lot is done behind the scenes in preparation.

Wow! The Art and Environment Ladies were at work Tuesday evening, and I think you will agree they did another outstanding job decorating the sanctuary area for Thanksgiving. Thank you, Ladies. I find it amazing that they work with what is donated or what they can find in the field or valley or along the road! God has blessed the members of our parish with many gifts and talents. This Thursday, 11 November, we celebrated Veteran's Day. There was very good attendance at our memorial service last Sunday afternoon, and we thank the members of the local American Legion for having this service of prayer and song and remembrance. God blessed us with a beautiful afternoon. As you know, I served as a chaplain in the Navy for 15 years, and I am very proud to serve God and to serve my country. Most, if not all, veterans would agree with me. It's about serving God and country.



Although her life was short, St. Elizabeth of Hungary (1207 – 1231) is recognized for her love of the poor and suffering, and as patroness of Catholic charities and the Secular Franciscan Order. The daughter of the King of Hungary, she chose a life of penance instead of leisure, which made an impact on the "commoners" she served.

St. Elizabeth married Louis of Thuringia when she was 14. Deeply in love, they had three children. Despite their wealth, she led a life of prayer, sacrifice, and service to the poor and sick under the spiritual direction of a Franciscan friar.

After six years of marriage, her husband died in the Crusades, and St. Elizabeth was grief stricken. Her husband's family did not look kindly


grief-stricken. Her husband's family did not look kindly upon her and mistreated her before finally throwing her out of the palace. However, the return of her husband's allies from the Crusades resulted in her being reinstated, since her son was legal heir to the throne.

St. Elizabeth joined the Secular Franciscan Order in 1228 where she cared for the poor in a hospital she founded in honor of St. Francis of Assisi. She died in 1231, but her great popularity resulted in her being named a saint only four years later.




