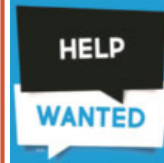
Thanksgiving Prayer

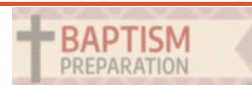

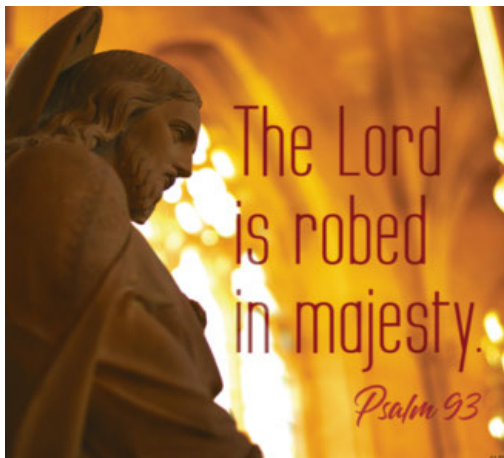
