From the Pastor

I'm sure some of you have read or heard about the Holy Father's consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The pope wishes a solemn Act of Consecration of humanity, especially Russia and Ukraine, to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Bishop Paprocki sent information via email to the pastors this past Tuesday informing us that he will join the Holy Father in his consecration of Russia and Ukraine on Friday, March 25 with a prayer service at the cathedral in Springfield. The prayer service was planned to go from 9 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. You can find information on our parish website and Facebook page.

On behalf of the local people, who will be helped this year because of your generosity to the Catholic Charities collection – thank you very much! I also thank our parish representatives to the Catholic Charities board – Karen Smith and Kent Probst. As you know, they spoke at our Masses on the weekend of 12-13 March. In that collection you gave \$12,170 to Catholic Charities. That's very generous.

The weekend after the Catholic Charities collection we had another second collection, and this was for the people of Ukraine and other eastern countries. This was in place of the collection on Ash Wednesday. May God bless your generosity. This collection was \$9,454.

Those, who read the numbers in the bulletin, know that our collections for tithing or church support have been holding steady all the way through the Covid pandemic. Last weekend you contributed \$18,155! This is remarkable when you consider the increase in costs like food, gasoline, clothes. Thank you for supporting your church. It's a sign of your gratitude to God for the blessings you enjoy. I believe that a grateful heart is a generous heart.

This Sunday is the diocesan wide listening sessions. At 2:00 p.m. today, Sunday, 27 March, groups across the diocese will connect with our bishop electronically by meeting in various parishes. Locally, we can meet at Sacred Heart Parish in Effingham or Immaculate Conception Parish in Mattoon. The bishop wants us to discuss the progress we have made since our synod five years ago; secondly reflections on synodality and evangelization – the idea of journeying together; and thirdly, some reflection on authentic discipleship. Our bishop is resuming his visitations in the parishes in the diocese. There are 129 parishes, and he intends the visiting to take him a few years to accomplish. He is coming here in October for a parish visit, administer the sacrament of Confirmation and to bless or dedicate our Sister Ethelbert Center.

We extend our condolences to the family of Tony Schumacher, who was buried from St. Francis Church this past Saturday. Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord. May he rest in peace.
