

From the Pastor

Please mark your calendar for the Community Charitable Cookout! As you know, the Teutopolis State Bank and Sigel Community Bank have a Charitable Cookout every year. This year the bank and its employees are raising funds to help the White Lily Project. This is a not for profit organization that will fund an Angel of Hope statue and a memorial garden across the street from St. Francis Church. This will be a place where parents, families and friends affected by miscarriage, infant loss and child loss can find hope and fellowship. You can enjoy a delicious meal and provide funds to help people memorialize their loved ones. 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, 13 May. It will be here before you know it.

I think the parishioners, who picked up their photos last weekend, are very pleased with the results. These pictures will go into the new directory. We try to produce a new directory every five years to keep pace with the growth of the children and the growth of the families! We need your help and cooperation to have an excellent book. I know we won't get 100% participation, but 90% is possible! You have looked into the directory to find someone and can't find them. They didn't take a photo or submit a photo the last time the parish did a directory.

Our high school students can be proud of their performance last weekend in the musical: "The Drowsy Chaperone." I try to sit directly in front of the large speakers on the sides, and I could hear most of the words from the dialogue and the singing. They provided some excellent comedy, and they put their talent and skills to work – the actors, the musicians in the pit, the stagehands, everyone did their share. Thank you for an entertaining show.

This past Wednesday evening, 27 April, we had the closing Mass for the religious ed program for the junior and senior high students. The members of the parish, especially the parents of these teens, are grateful to the 8 junior high catechists and the 6 high school catechists; 1 helper, 3 substitute teachers and many parent helpers on Wednesday evenings. We had 98 junior high students and 74 high school students participating in the program. They donated 663 hours of service during the year.

And our Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults concluded this past Monday evening. They were very impressed with the liturgy at the Easter Vigil as they entered the darkened church, and then participated with the rite of light, so to speak, with the Easter candle. We are grateful to Anne Marie Brummer and her team of catechists for their generosity in sharing their faith with the searchers and seekers. We all have so much more to learn about our faith.




