#### From the Pastor

Everyone, who came to our St. Francis Music Ministry Program last Sunday afternoon, certainly had an enjoyable time as our Adult Choir, Brass Ensemble, Children's Choir and our Guitar Group participated in "An Afternoon of Joy." God has certainly been generous to the members of our parish in bestowing many and varied gifts, especially in the area of music. On the back of the program, there are many names for all the people in the groups, and we are grateful to them for sharing their gifts with the parish. There were a couple names missing on the brochure: Dan and Sandy Williams! Dan has been our Director of Music for the past few years, and he would be the first to say he owes a good deal to his wife, Sandy. They make quite a team. They originated the idea, as far as I know, and they have been working on it. Very well done, and very much appreciated. A free will offering was taken up, and \$1,932.00 was contributed. This will go towards improving the equipment we use for our liturgical music. Thank you.

Monday is Memorial Day, and we will have Mass at 9:00 a.m. at the cemetery. On Memorial Day we honor all the men and women, who have died in the service of our country. It's likely that each of us knows one person, who died on active duty. You might wish to bring a chair for the Mass.

This Sunday afternoon, 29 May, our local American Legion has a memorial service at the cemetery at 1:00. You'll want to bring a chair. We remember and honor our service people as well as all the deceased, especially the people buried in our cemetery. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord.

If you ever get the chance to visit our national cemetery outside Washington, D. C. in Arlington, VA, be sure to visit this cemetery. You won't regret it. Row after row of cemetery markers, up and down the hills, and it gives the impression of ranks of soldiers standing in line. The markers form straight lines. The place where John F. Kennedy is buried has his eternal flame, and there are several famous quotes from his many speeches. His brother, Robert, is buried near to him. The closest thing to Arlington in our vicinity would be the Jefferson Barracks Cemetery on the south side of St. Louis.

During the month of June we are not going to have nearly as many Masses as we usually have during the week. For example, starting Monday, 6 June, there will be only one Mass each weekday, and that will be at 6:30 a.m. I will be joining priests of the diocese on retreat that week. I usually do this and find the time rewarding. We are moving to a different retreat house this year. Please keep your parish priests and the priests of the diocese in your prayers. Thank you. Tuesday, 7 June, is my ordination anniversary, and this year marks 47 years! 1975 was a good year! It's hard for me to believe it is so many years. God has blessed me indeed, more than I ever deserved. The following week of June, starting the 13<sup>th</sup>, there will NOT be any Mass on weekdays for that week. The friars will be in St. Louis for the Provincial Chapter. The next two weeks of June there will be only a 6:30 weekday Mass. So mark your calendars!


