From the Pastor

The feast of Pentecost! Today we celebrate what has been called “the birthday of the Church.” We remember and call to mind the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles. I asked the parishioners to wear red to Mass this weekend because the priest will be wearing red vestments to celebrate the fire of the Holy Spirit coming upon the church. It’s really the only Sunday in the year when I have asked the people to wear a certain color of apparel. When we are all wearing red, we celebrate the Spirit being alive and working in our lives!

There was very good attendance at the parish Memorial Mass in the cemetery Monday morning at 9 o’clock. It was a beautiful, sunny morning, and we had a breeze! Estimate is 120 people or so. We are grateful to Eric Habing for hooking up the speaker system, bringing out the liturgical materials, and Dan Williams and Tracy Dennis for leading the song.

During the summer months we will NOT have confessions on Tuesday and Thursday evenings like we have during the school year. Confessions will be available on Saturday from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m.

Keep in mind that during June we have a major event for the Franciscans. This event will take place in St. Louis, and all friars in the Province are expected to attend. So from 13 to 17 June there will NOT be a weekday Mass at St. Francis. Please keep the friars in your prayers.

The other weekdays in June there will be ONLY the 6:30 Mass. I will be gone for retreat with the diocesan priests 6 to 10 June, and then both Fr. Dat and I will be at Chapter in St. Louis 13-17 June, and then I will take my vacation the last two weeks of June.

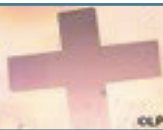

ASSISI FOR AFRICA - Fr. Damien has plans to visit his family and hopefully our parish sometime this summer! He shared some heartbreaking news recently: "one silent night our treasured boy Didier died in the middle of the night, in the arms of those who were helping him. He had asked to eat one of the bananas I had left on his table and then he left us, knowing that he would never get well. He was bleeding until the end. This was truly a heart wrenching experience for we had been with him day by day for 2 plus years ... After this shock another boy named Jean returned to his heavenly father and to Didier. He was epileptic and in the midst of the night he had a seizure that took him away from us. Once again our older boys dug the graves and in the case of Jean washed the body of the boy before putting him in the grave. Because of lack of money and transportation most of our kids had to stay home during the burial. A closing information: it seems that the government can no longer support the thousands of street children living on the streets and active delinquents. It has already sent hundreds to a formation "farm" where they will learn discipline and some kind of work, even military work. Our kids on the streets are trembling a bit and some want to find refuge with us. This is our new situation. God help us. Blessings on you all and please join us in prayer."

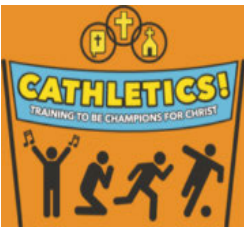
