

#### From the Pastor

Please remember the friars from the province as they meet for the Provincial Chapter in St. Louis. This will likely be our last Chapter as a province since the provinces are being consolidated. There is a sadness involved with the consolidation. But we have to believe that God's hand is involved with this process. Appreciate your prayers.

I think it would be a good idea for the ministers of the Sunday Masses to try to check in with the sacristan at least 10 minutes before Mass. I don't think 10 minutes is a long time, but it will certainly be a cause of relief for the sacristan to know that the extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist are present, the servers are getting ready in the sacristy, the reader is going over the first and second readings for the Mass, and the sacristan doesn't have to go out before Mass and try to figure out who is a reader, or a Eucharistic minister or an acolyte or Mass server. If it is getting close to Mass time, and the sacristan finds another server to help at Mass or a reader, who needs to prepare the readings for the Mass, then that person will have that ministerial role even if the assigned person comes in to the sacristy two minutes before Mass time! It is a matter of courtesy, and the sacristan will certainly appreciate everyone working together.

Last Sunday we celebrated the feast of Pentecost. Thank you to those who remembered to wear red at Mass, and I'm sure others remembered, but they don't have anything red to wear. They're probably Cubs fans! Next Sunday we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, the Body of Christ. After the 10:30 Mass we will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament and offer benedictions. This custom has a long tradition in many parishes. Today we celebrate the feast of the Blessed Trinity, the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Three persons but only one God. It's a mystery that we will never be able to understand.


