

From the Pastor

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, the Body of Christ. One can argue about which feast is the greatest during the year, but one can make a case for Corpus Christi being up near the top of the greatest. Jesus could not have given us a greater gift at the Last Supper than the Eucharist when he said: this is my body. This is my blood. How does this transubstantiation happen? How does ordinary bread and ordinary wine become the body and blood of Christ? We are most grateful, and we have to keep a constant watch that we receive the Lord with intention so Communion doesn't become automatic because we receive so often. We celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi with a procession after the 10:30 Mass and benedictions at two sites outdoors with the final benediction back in church.

Our celebrant for the 10:30 Mass is Fr. Dominic Vahling, the son of Tom and Cindy Vahling from our parish. He wrote me and asked if he could concelebrate a Mass this Sunday, and I asked him if he would like to celebrate the 10:30 Mass with the procession and benedictions. He said yes! It's a real honor for the parishioners to welcome home their son, who was ordained on the 19th of June 2020. I'm sure his parents are overjoyed to see their son at the altar.

Not only is today the feast of Corpus Christi, a major feast in the church year, but today is also Father's Day. We congratulate all of our fathers, grandfathers, stepfathers and all who have reached out to us as a Dad over the years. We ask God to bless and reward them for all that they have done and continue to do for our families. The saying goes: a happy wife is a happy life. And another way of putting it is: a happy spouse is a happy house. I hope our children can find a significant way of letting their fathers know how much they love them.

I plan on leaving early Monday for Buffalo, NY to visit my sister. Used to do this trip in one day, but I don't know if that's going to happen this year. The trip seems longer each time I make it. If you have a second or two, please pray I have a safe trip. From my sister's, I'm heading to friends in Virginia – this has been the pattern the last couple of years.








PRAY FOR PEACE!
