



#### **CD** of A Contest Winning Entry

This week we congratulate Hudson Einhorn, son of Greg and Beth Einhorn, (student of Karen Buhnerkempe) on placing 1<sup>st</sup> place in Division I for his essay.

The fact that I am here writing this right now is proof that with God all things are possible. My mom and dad have told me this all my life. I was born at 26 weeks and since (birthdate), God has been proving that all things are possible through Him.

When my twin sister and I were born, we both weighed 2 pounds. The doctors were worried about me because I am a boy and premature boys do not have good lungs. The doctors thought that I would not live. But, my parents prayed and prayed for my sister, Harper, and I. Harper and I were both on machines called oscillators and ventilators to help us breathe. We were already showing the doctors that all things are possible with God. A month after we were born, my sister had heart problems and she died and went to heaven. Mom and dad say that she must have been watching over me because the day of her funeral, I came off all the machines and started breathing on my own. I was in the NICU for 2 ½ months and finally I got to come home.

A few days before I came home, my mom and dad were told that I would probably have a lot of problems. They said I could have learning disabilities, bad eyesight, maybe never talk or walk correctly, and might have autism. Still, my parents prayed and prayed for me. All things are possible with God. I had therapy almost everyday to help me with motor skills. I started walking late, but it was only because I started talking early. God was listening to my mom and dad. I was checked for autism every year until I was four and everything was looking great. God was making a miracle out of me because I was a miracle. Today, mom and dad still pray for me and God still makes things possible. I started at two pounds and now I am taller than the average 11 year old. I used to be on breathing machines and today, I run and play with no problems. The doctors were worried that I would have problems walking and currently I love playing baseball and basketball. When I left the NICU, my parents were told that I might have difficulties learning and today I am a smart kid who loves school. I beat the odds because with God all things are possible.

On (birthdate), I proved to everyone that with God all things are possible. My sister and I were born early, but we had fighting spirits and parents who prayed to God. With God all things are possible and I am living proof of this.


