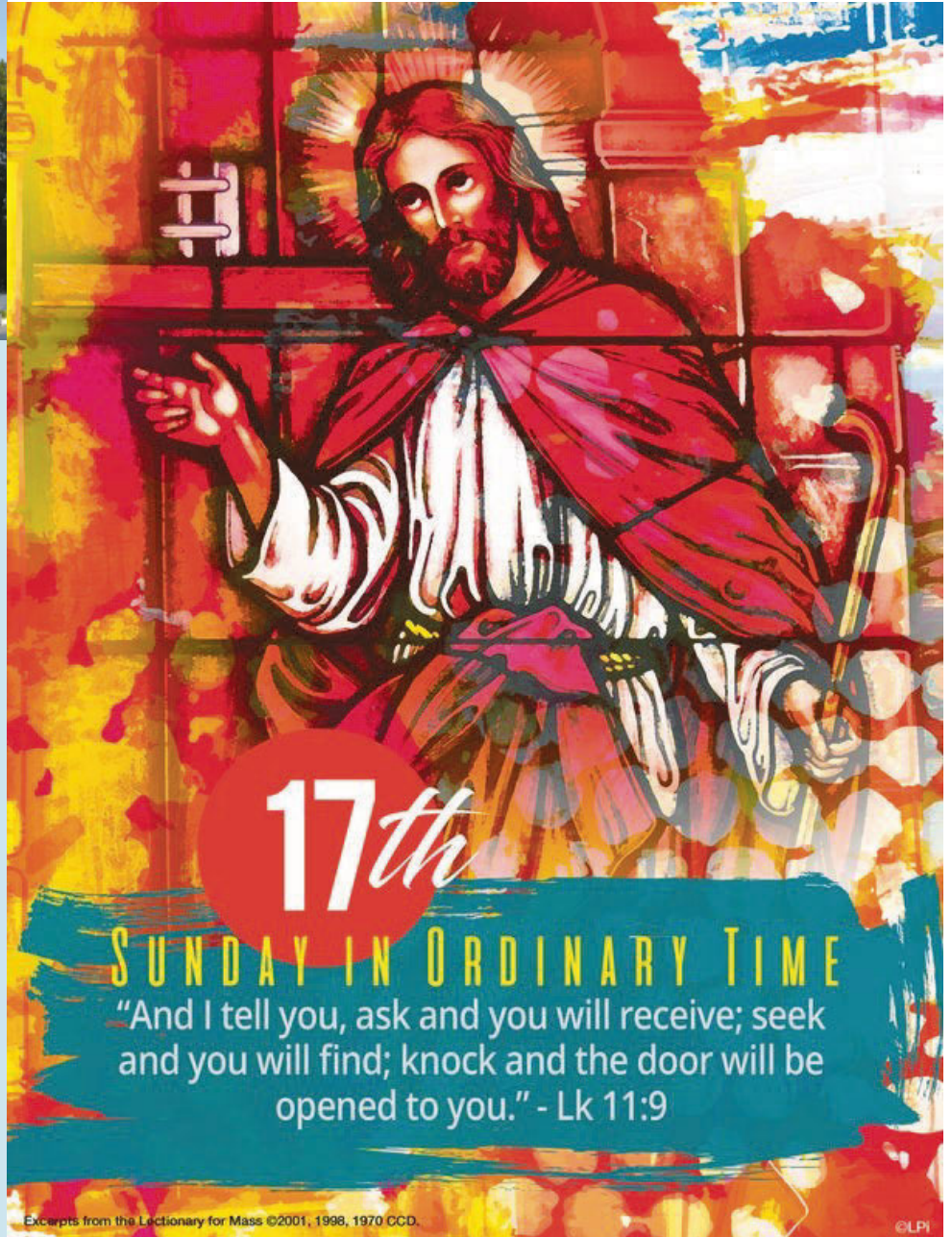

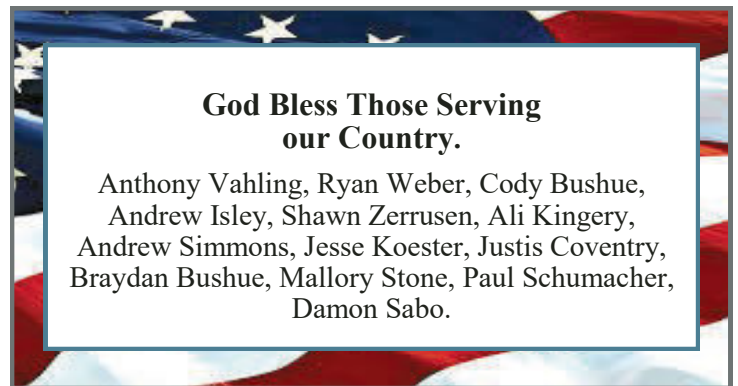

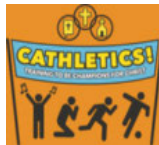
Religious Education Registration for 2022-2023 School Year is now available.

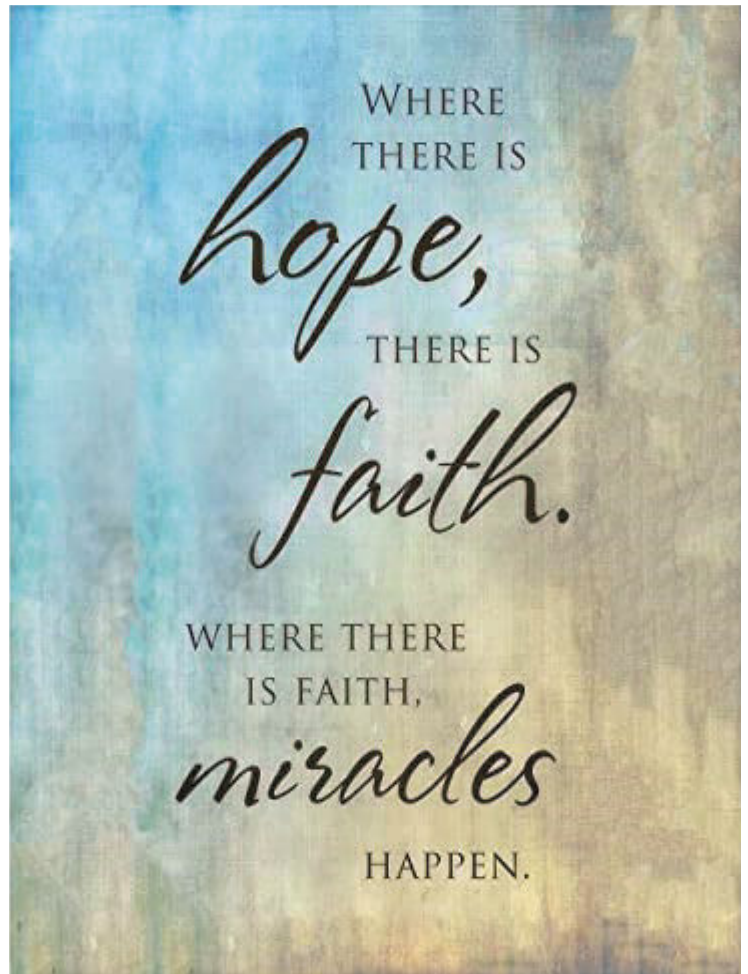

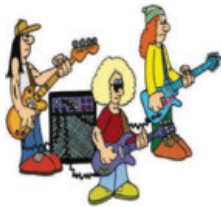
