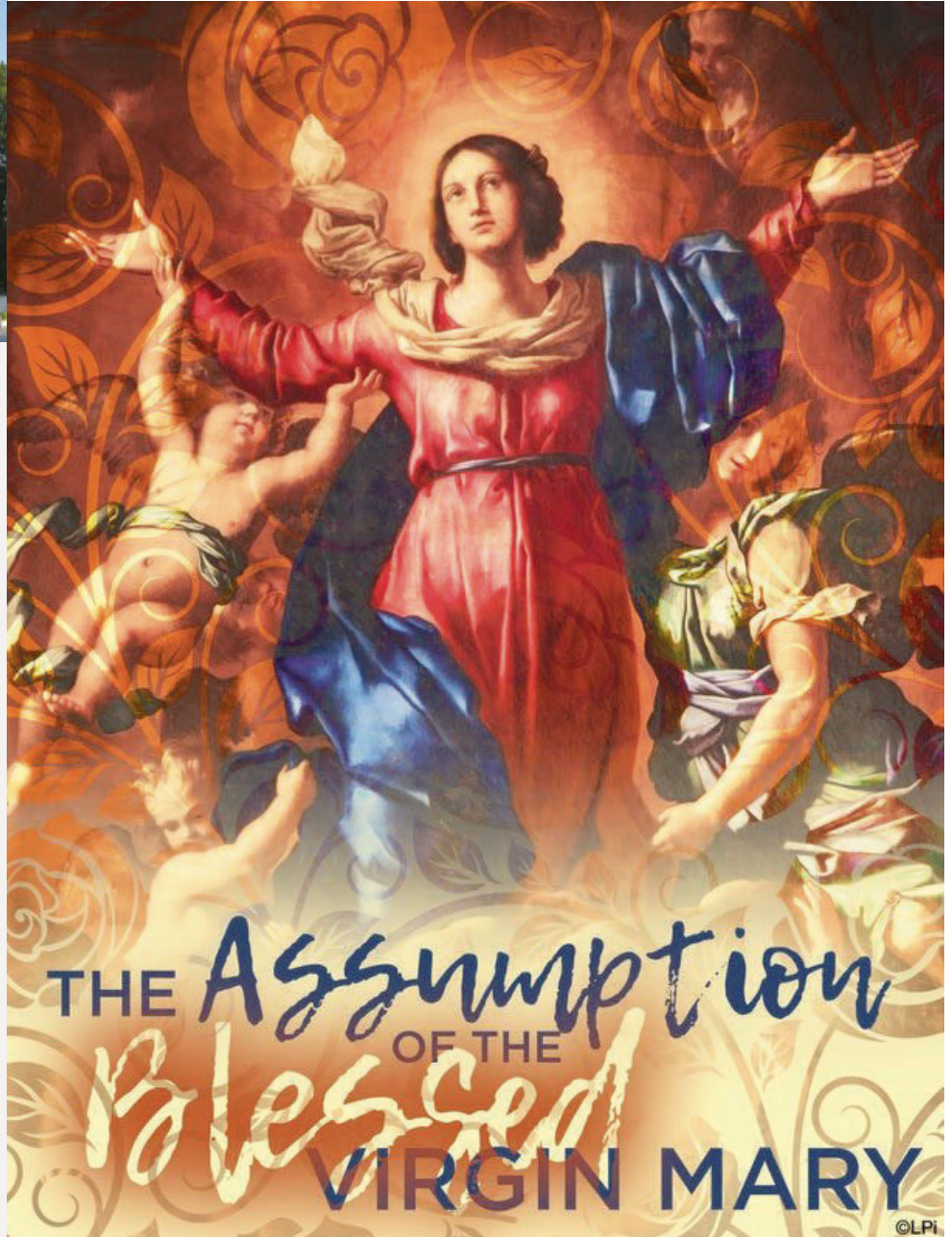

From the Pastor

Monday is the 15th of August and the feast of the Assumption of Mary. Normally it would be a holy day of obligation, but this year most Catholics are not obligated to participate in the Mass on the feast of the Assumption. Here at St. Francis we will have two Masses: the usual Mass at 6:30 and then an additional Mass at 12:10 pm for the feast of the Assumption.

In the mail last week came an envelope from a parishioner, and there was a check enclosed for \$138.89. Along with the check was a record of payments for the past 35 months. This was the final payment. The first one was on 9/1/20, and this final one was 8/8/22. 36 payments make a total of \$5,000.00! Wow! Thank you very much. I also thank all of you, who have participated in the payment for the Sr. Ethelbert Center. Many people have expressed their appreciation for the Center, and they are proud of what the parish has put together. Contributions continue to come in as parishioners make their final payments towards the Center. We are also gathering funds towards the payment of the east wall. When I walk around the mini-park, praying my rosary, I am grateful that our children are not crawling through holes in the brick wall that was over 100 years old! If someone would like to make a special donation, we have two large items: a new roof for the church and new kneelers in the church. I have told a couple people that we are going to put solar panels on the whole west side of the roof of the church!! This will pay the electric bill for years to come. I don't think they believed me! Nor should they. It has never been proposed. On these hot summer days think of the amount of energy that could be stored from the sun.

I hope the Lord blessed us with good weather for Band Night, this Saturday evening, August 13th. There was a good deal of activity through town last year for the Band Night celebration - all the talents God has given our community, and many came together for music and song and entertainment. We thank God for the many blessings bestowed upon the members of our community – playing many instruments and the voices that give praise to the Lord. Thank you for sharing your gifts and talents.

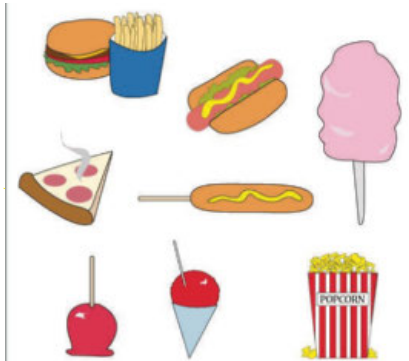
