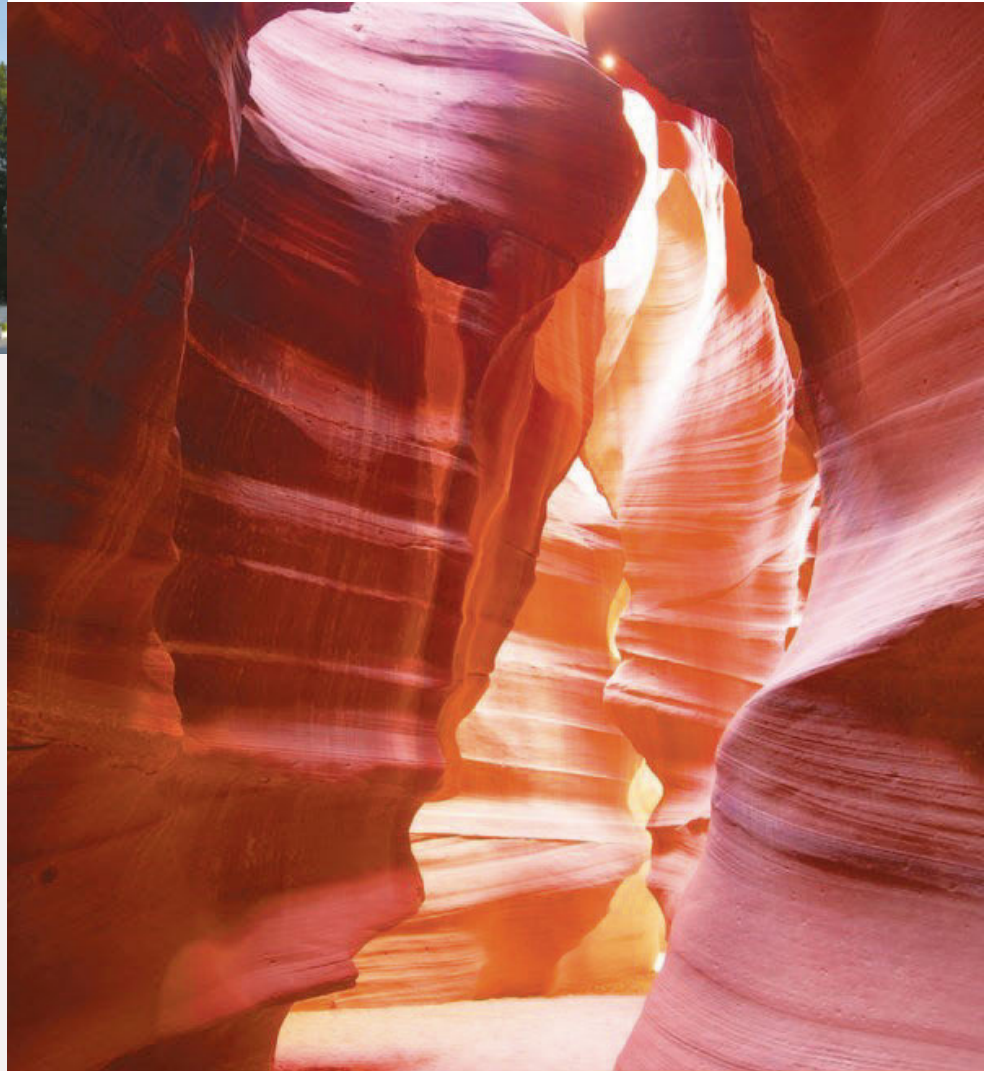

From the Pastor

This week our children returned to school after their summer break or vacation. Some were ready to join their friends and classmates again in the classroom, while others could have waited a while longer, like 2 or 3 months! We could have a survey or a contest and see how many teachers are honestly ready to return!

We are thankful that there were no serious accidents that involved our children and our families this summer. It would be interesting to add up the number of miles that all of our families traveled this summer. It would be a high number, and we are grateful to God for keeping us safe.

From the news we learn that some school districts across our country are starting school with an absence of teachers. The communities are really hurting, and school boards are lowering their standards for educators just in order to have teachers in the classrooms. Our community is grateful to our educators for their hard work and dedication in preparing our students in the educational process. And we thank the support staff like cooks, maintenance, bus drivers – it takes a lot of people for a community to educate its children.

A major requirement for an effective educational process is cooperation between parents and teachers. In the past apparently there was excellent cooperation between the teachers and the parents. 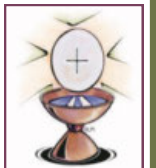
