Thank you for calling me to be a catechist, for the opportunity to share with others what you have given to me.


May all those with whom I share the gift of faith discover how you are present in all things.

From the Pastor

Our parishioners extend their condolences to the family of Fred Meyer, whose funeral was this past Monday. Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord.

All I can say is that I hope when Saturday, 17 Sept, arrives God will give us a picnic day with favorable weather. By the time you are reading this, we are either celebrating our picnic, or it is history. Some people are happy to have the picnic in their rearview mirror – they have thought about, planned, discussed, prayed over and worked with others to create an excellent opportunity for the parishioners – and our guests – to come together and celebrate the Eucharist outside and then to visit with others, work together, and have fun. I am hoping fun memories are created.

Reminder: the priests will be gone this week for our Fall Clergy Convocation. We will have only one Mass Monday thru Thursday this week, and that Mass is at 6:30. On Friday, 22 Sept, we will have both the 6:30 and the 8:00 Masses. There will not be evening confessions at 6:15 on this Tuesday and Thursday. It is mandatory that pastors attend the Tuesday evening talk by our bishop. Fr. Dennis doesn't have to attend this session so he has volunteered to provide the 6:30 Masses while Fr. Dat and I are gone.

This Sunday, 18 Sept, is Catechetical Sunday, a time for us to thank the many teachers and catechists and their helpers as well as the cast of hundreds, who pitch in with our religious education program. Whether it's greeting children at the grade school when their parents drop them off, or escorting the children over to church for Mass, or sharing their faith with them in the classroom, or in some other way making it possible for our children to learn more about God and our faith – we have generous people, stewards of the gifts God has given them. There are close to 130 parishes in our diocese, and to the best of my knowledge we stand alone in our religious ed program. YOU make it possible. YOU sacrifice and come to the school – either in the morning or on Wednesday evening – or even some other time. Our children thank you. Our parents thank you. All of us in the parish are grateful to you. Continue the good work God has begun in you.
