From the Pastor

The blessing of animals is today, Sunday, Oct 2nd, at 1:00 in the green space north of the grotto north of the grade school. This is the Sunday nearest the feast of St. Francis of Assisi, our patron. His feast day is Tuesday, October 4th.

The Transitus will be celebrated on Monday evening at 6:00 in church. When we celebrate the Transitus, we are remembering the passing of St. Francis from this life into eternal life. All are welcome afterwards to come to the friary for refreshments.

This Saturday, October 8th, Bishop Thomas John Paprocki will celebrate the 4:30 Mass during which he will confirm our youngsters. They will also receive our Lord in Holy Communion for the first time. We congratulate them and their families as they mark this milestone in their lives.

On the next day, Sunday, Bishop Paprocki will celebrate the 8:30 Mass and greet our parishioners afterwards. He will then bless and consecrate our new Sr. Ethelbert Center. It has opened to a slow start because of the COVID restrictions, but it has been used several times for funeral dinners, meetings, taking of photos for our pictorial directory. When parishioners came for posing for their photo, this was the first time most of them saw the new center. We thank Bishop Paprocki for blessing this building, and we ask God to bless the activities that will take place in this center in the future.

After Bishop Paprocki blesses our new center he will join the members of the parish council for a brunch. Then the members of the parish council will present a brief to Bishop on the parish, especially from the perspective of stewardship. They will concentrate on the 4 main pillars.

I know it has been two weeks since our picnic, and much has happened in the community! Oktoberfest and the Catholic Charities bartender fundraiser are only a couple of the festivities. Not all the bills are in yet for the picnic, but from all the positive comments I have been hearing, this picnic will go down in history as a great one.


