From the Pastor

Our parishioners extend our condolences to the family of Linus Nosbisch. His funeral is Monday, October 17, Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord.

We are grateful to Bishop Paprocki for making the trip to Teutopolis last weekend and confirming over 50 children; mainly from St. Francis Parish. A couple children came from St. Rose of Lima, and a couple children from St. Isidore's were confirmed. They attend religion classes here during the week. Bishop not only confirmed the children, but he also administered the Eucharist to the newly confirmed. It was their first Communion.

Sunday morning Bishop Paprocki presided at the 8:30 Mass, and then he came to the Sr. Ethelbert Center and dedicated or blessed this new addition to our parish. After that he enjoyed brunch with members of the parish and finance councils. Following brunch there was a discussion between the bishop and the councils. Members briefed our bishop about what is happening here at St. Francis, and our bishop reminded us of the synod that was held in the diocese a few years ago. There was a frank and candid discussion about the topic of people going to the cathedral for Confirmation. No dishes or cups were thrown in either direction!

I think Bishop Paprocki was impressed by what he saw and experienced here this weekend. I know I am proud of our parish, and I'm glad to be the shepherd. We are a work in progress, and we have much to accomplish. Points to ponder are what can we do to engage more people in our parish life, like coming to Mass. As you know, during the month of October we have the "Parish Count" at all the Masses. We do this every Sunday. I will let you know next month whether we are any better than where we were before the Covid panedemic. My guess is that we are still below what the attendance was then. I don't think the pandemic helped us. Some people got used to not coming to Mass on Sunday, and they haven't returned. Others, for good medical reasons, are steering clear of getting too physically close like we do at Mass.

<u>Rosary at the Tower this Sunday at 7 o'clock</u>. The Knights of Columbus traditionally have sponsored praying the rosary outside near the tower on a Sunday evening in October. This Sunday is the day. Come and pray as a family. Children are more likely to remember what they DID when they were growing up rather than what someone said. Praying the rosary together outside is something they will remember. Bring your children. Pray the rosary with your family.


