*From the Pastor*

The parishioners extend our condolences to the family of Luella Buscher, who was buried from St. Francis Church this past Monday. Eternal rest grant unto her, O Lord.

This Sunday, November 13, is our annual Cemetery Service for our parishioners and Veterans. The time is one o'clock at the cemetery.

At the time of this writing the mid-term elections have not taken place yet. Regardless of the outcome, I suspect many of our parishioners will be happy to not see the same political advertisements on television repeatedly.

They did it again! You had to notice the work of our Art and Environment Committee with the altars when you came to Mass last weekend. Beautiful! And they have no idea what kind of this and how many of that they will have to work with until the day when our parishioners bring the materials to church! Then the creative energy of the committee goes to work. We are all grateful to the committee for how their gifts give thanks to God and beautify our church.

This Thursday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, is our Anointing Mass at 12:10. If you are going to be anointed, then please sit in the front section of the church, and please use every other pew so the priests can move freely from person to person. It is the sacrament for the sick, the person does not have to be in danger of death! Previously this sacrament was called Extreme Unction, the final anointing. And some people called it the "last rites." Today the emphasis is on healing the person physically and spiritually. You can receive the sacrament multiple times. There is a meal afterwards for the 55+ folks.

The following Thursday, November 24<sup>th</sup>, is Thanksgiving Day. We have Masses at 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. The term "Eucharist" means thanksgiving. Is there a better way to give thanks to God than to come to Mass as a family, a community, and give the Lord thanks on Thanksgiving Day and every day?

As announced in the bulletin for 6 Nov, this Sunday, the 13<sup>th</sup>, we are taking a collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA. Dioceses are supported in various ways. We used to have ACSA: Annual Catholic Services Appeal, where the diocese sent a bill to each parish for their ACSA. That went away, and today each parish tithes with the diocese, sending in 10% of each collection. The AMS cannot do this. The AMS is responsible for serving all the people in the military and VA hospitals and embassies. Each Catholic chaplain in the military is endorsed by the AMS. A priest doesn't just contact the Army and volunteer to serve. Any baptism, confirmation or wedding is recorded in the AMS office in Washington, DC. The AMS has 3 or 4 bishops who travel to any base in whatever country to administer Confirmation and support the chaplain. If you would like to make a donation after this Sunday, then simply write a check to the parish, and in the memo section put: AMS. We will combine the checks and send one donation to the AMS. This collection is once every three years. It is certainly a worthy cause.

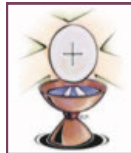
