From the Pastor

Thursday is Thanksgiving Day. We have Masses at 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Bring your family to Mass Thanksgiving morning, and then cheer the guys on as they play football in the yard! "Let us give thanks to the Lord!"

I find numbers interesting. As you know, we take the October count at all Masses during the month of October. We do this each year as do other parishes in the diocese and beyond. The ushers also take a count at all Masses on the weekends. It's a "clean" metric vice guessing at how many were at this Mass or that Mass. Some might ask: "Is our attendance at weekend Masses where it was before COVID?" Or is it a matter of not coming back yet? Here are some numbers I think you'll find interesting. The numbers reflect attendance at all Masses on the weekends of October for the pertinent year.



One might ask what happened in 2022 to have such a large number. Recall our bishop came to St. Francis for Confirmation at the vigil Mass on 8 November. This explains the larger number in attendance for 2022. 2020 was a remarkably lower number compared with years prior and after, and this 2020 is the COVID year. I think the answer to the question is that our parish has come through the COVID experience. It will be interesting to see what the attendance is for the next couple years. One thing we know is that our bishop will not be coming for Confirmation for a few years.

Since we are in the spirit of Thanksgiving, I want to thank you, our parishioners, for your sense of stewardship in our community. It makes all the difference in the world. Our religious education program is possible for only one reason: all the volunteers each day. This is stewardship, returning to God our time and our talents. We wouldn't have a religious education program without all the people stepping up to the plate. I also thank you for the stewardship with the Art and Environment Committee. Thanksgiving and Advent and Christmas is their time to shine, and they glow! Giving our creative talents back to the Master is what it's all about. That's stewardship. Our collections have been steady and even increasing – we usually think of money and stewardship. Financial donations are only part of stewardship. I think of all the people making it possible for our teens to come to the Teen Center on Friday evenings. Who thanks them? The liturgical ministers, serving as a reader, Eucharistic Minister, cantor, server at Mass, usher, musician, sacristan, choirs, parish council, finance council – a good parish is all these people and more! I have probably inadvertently omitted someone, and I'm sorry. Everyone's effort is significant and is a part of stewardship. And I thank you for doing your part to make us an excellent parish. Perfect? No one is. But we keep trying. Remember the Saints: they kept trying!






