

From the Pastor

If you couldn't attend our music program last Sunday afternoon, which incorporated all the various groups in our music ministry, then you missed a beautiful experience. Thank you to Dan Williams and his wife, Sandy, for all the work they put into the program. I got worn out just watching Dan move around from group to group in the church!! God has certainly gifted the members of our community in so many ways, and music is one of them. This is another example of stewardship – think of the time the groups spent preparing and getting ready, plus the performance in the afternoon. Thank you to all who participated.

Seems difficult to believe, but it's true: Christmas is only one week away!!! I remember getting excited as Christmas drew near, and I was 67 years old at the time! Seriously, excitement does grow especially for our children as the days march closer to Christmas Eve and of course Christmas. For older people, mothers for example, I'm not sure "excitement" is the term to use to describe the emotions we experience as we get closer to the big day. It could be a time of stress and deadlines, making sure all the "t's" are crossed. Christmas is a time for love. We are reminded of the love Jesus has that he would empty himself of his divinity and take on our humanity. We receive the love of Jesus and share that love with others.

I thank those of you for participating in the Giving Tree program this year. Some of you have been steady members of this group and have shopped and wrapped presents for many years, and you have no idea who received them! When I see that pile of gift wrapped packages in front of the Blessed Mother's altar, just before they are taken out to be distributed, I marvel at the love God has for us and the love we have for others, bringing the love of Christ to all. It is an excellent example of stewardship, sharing God's blessings with others.

Please keep in mind this Tuesday, December 20th, when we'll have the opportunity for you to receive the sacrament of reconciliation. There will be 3 priests available, possibly four if we can find another "confessional." We start at 7:00 p.m. with confessions. There isn't a Penance Service or Scripture Service first. We will continue with the sacrament until the last confession is heard. If it has been a long time since you have experienced the power of God's forgiveness and mercy, then give yourself a Christmas present. Come to confession. The last scheduled time for confessions is Thursday, Dec 22nd, from 6:15 to 6:45.


