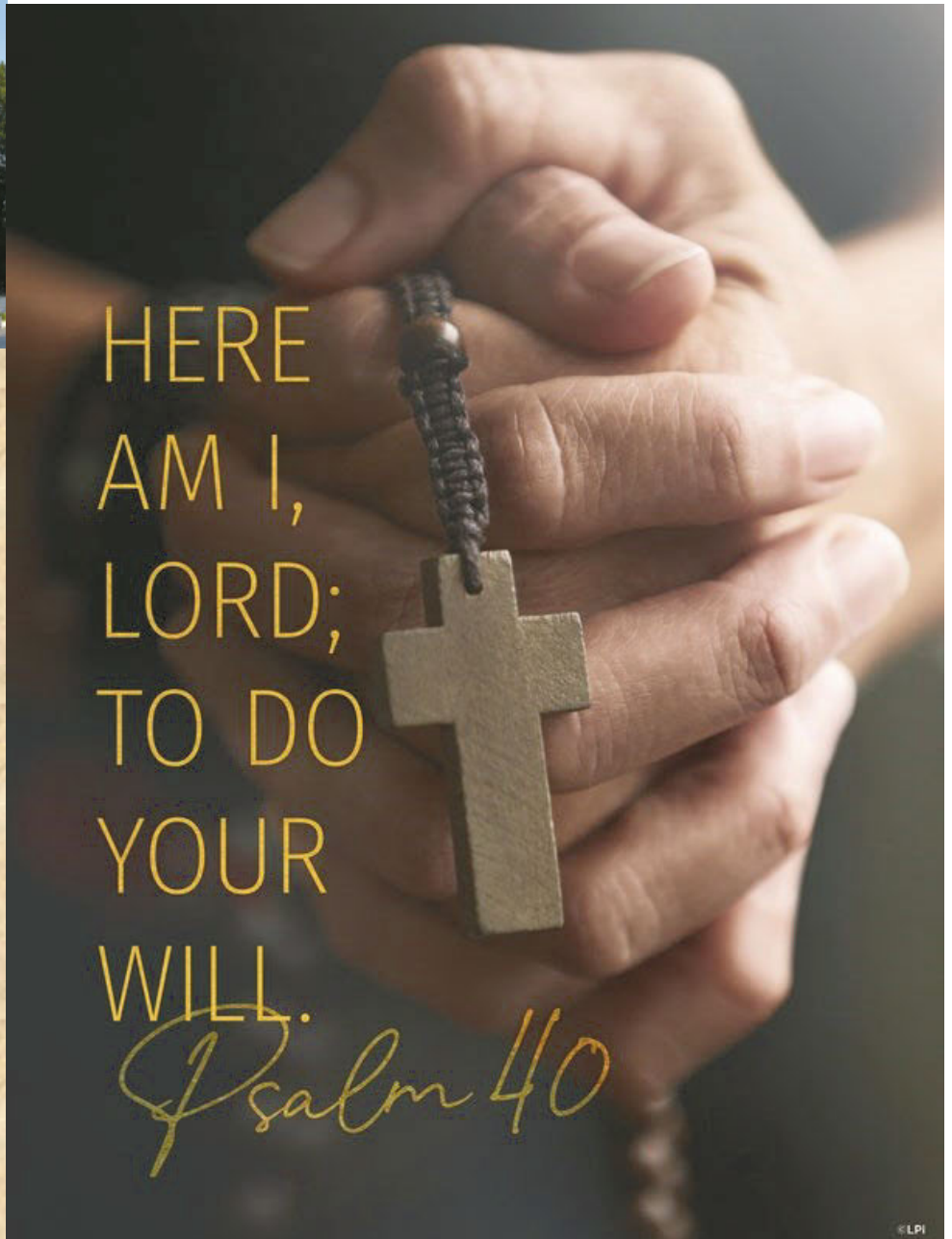

From the Pastor

I never get tired of hearing people comment about the beauty of our church. And during the season of Christmas this is especially true. We can again thank and express our gratitude to the many people responsible for decorating our church and also taking down the decorations and placing them in the proper place. This is not an easy task – as we can imagine. Removing the stable in front of the Blessed Mother’s altar, taking down the wreaths on the choir loft, putting the trees back where they will stay for the next several months, and the list goes on – it’s the work of many men and women. Our church will seem so “quiet” or “still” now with the decorations for Christmas put away. May God bless our members of the Art and Environment Committee – and their helpers - for all they do.

For those, who read the bulletin, you might have noticed the contributions or the part of the bulletin “Stewardship of Treasure” that appeared for last Sunday, January 8, 2023. I can’t imagine parishes that have these numbers on a regular basis, and they need that amount to meet the needs of the parish – a large grade school with faculty, maintenance issues on an aging complex of buildings, standard supplies for liturgical uses, etc. Some parishioners contribute once a year, and that is reflected in the numbers I refer to. I don’t listen to the Sunday homilies of the other priests here, but I would be surprised if any of them “harp” on your giving more money. That seems to be a complaint with some parishes – “all the pastor does is talk of money.” I think it’s a conscience issue – do I give a return to God for the many blessings God has given me? That’s stewardship. It is not only money but also time and talent.

The officers for the Holy Name Society and the Council of Catholic Women – those officers coming and retiring – met for a Christmas party last Sunday afternoon. No one “begs” to be chosen for these positions, but with a spirituality of stewardship, people give their time and talent to God and the Church. The parishioners are grateful to these men and women for all they do.

We are having a special Mass on Monday, January 23rd, at 6:30 p.m. for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. This is part of a national Day of Prayer for the same purpose. I encourage you to come and pray for the weakest members of our society. Who will defend them? Who will protect them? You will!
