

#### From the Pastor

I am reading the book Teutopolis Sesquicentennial 1839-1989. On page 91 of this work you will find: "In November of 1966, the Wooden Shoes ended the St. Anthony Bulldogs streak of 27 consecutive conference wins. As usual the game was wild and wooly. A total of 50 fouls were called." That had to be an exciting game. On the same page the reader will learn: "Teutopolis High School received a new scoreboard – one of the very latest, which included the players' names and fouls. It was used for the first time for the Newton game on February 14, 1967." Think it's the same scoreboard we use today?!

If you didn't know it, you do now, that our ushers are busy at each Mass on the weekend counting the people in attendance. Every parish does this in the month of October. The diocese uses "The October Count" for its planning and discussion. We continue the practice here at St. Francis because it gives us an accurate metric, or at least as accurate as our ushers present us. For those of you with a curious streak, for January our total for the Masses for the four weekends was 5,238 souls. There were four weekends, so our average for the weekend is 1,310 people. This does not take into account any weddings or possible funerals on Saturdays. The most crowded Mass was Saturday, the 22<sup>nd</sup>, when we had 540 people at the 4:30! That is a match for attendance at the 6:00 Mass Christmas Eve, and it is more than the 10:00 on the eve and the 9:00 Christmas morning! Why so many people? The children sang at this Mass. There were 30+ children in the choir loft, and many wanted to come and pray and hear them sing. Under the excellent direction of Mr. Dan Williams, the children do a wonderful job.

In case you didn't get a bulletin last weekend, we are looking for volunteers to serve funeral Masses. I have a small group of retired men, who do a wonderful job, but I don't want to keep calling the same people. No experience is necessary, and you don't need to be able to speak Latin! Just call the parish office. Thank you.






