From the Pastor

The parishioners of St. Francis Parish extend our condolences to the family of Leon Barnes, whose funeral was this Friday. Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him.

At adoration this week our people saw something new. We bought a tabor (Ta-bor) to hold the monstrance during times of exposition. I am quoting this information: the word "tabor" is a direct reference to Mt. Tabor, the mountain traditionally believed to be the place where Jesus was transfigured before three of his closest apostles. Local tradition concerning Mt. Tabor can be traced back to the early centuries of Christianity and so it is a likely candidate for the gospel event. The tabor is a small stand that lifts the monstrance higher, allowing a better view for the congregation kneeling or sitting in the pews. This is paid for from the memorial fund.

Tuesday was Valentine's Day. The U.S. Greeting Card Association estimates that approximately 190 million valentines are sent each year in the U.S. When the valentine-exchanged cards made in school activities are included the figure goes up to 1 billion, and teachers become the people receiving the most valentines. The average valentine's spending has increased every year in the U.S., from \$108 a person in 2010 to \$111 in 2013.

Over the past decade people have slowed down because of the over-commercialization of the holiday; not having a significant other; and not being interested. I was surprised that it is a big day in other countries.

In 1969 there was a revision of the Roman Catholic Calendar of Saints, and St. Valentine on February 14 was removed. Though the memorial of St. Valentine is ancient, apart from his name, nothing is known of St. Valentine except that he was buried on the Via Flaminia on February 14th.

Two men have stepped up to the plate to volunteer to serve funerals. Thank you, Gentlemen. Can still use a couple more. Please consider it. Training will be provided. And the more volunteers there are, the less times I will call you!

LENTEN REGULATIONS

- 1. ABSTINENCE Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. FAST Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.


