From the Pastor

We are well on the journey! On Ash Wednesday we began our Lenten journey of 40 days. Please do yourself a favor and don't wait until Holy Week to think to yourself: "I should really do something for lent." Some of us have been thinking long before Ash Wednesday about our plan for making the most of these days of prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

A couple weeks ago I spoke at all the Masses about: "it is what it is, but it's not what it could be." We can use this special time of lent to move from what is to what can be. Maybe we have slipped into a mode of complacency, and we are satisfied with a minimum amount of effort. OK, what does the Church require of us?

All Fridays are days of abstinence – if we are over 14 years old, then we don't eat meat. Years ago I had breakfast one morning at the Kountry Kitchen, with three ladies, older than I was, and they were convinced that the church requires us to abstain from meat from our 14th birthday until we are 70 years old!!! I told them they were making this up, that it was never a teaching of the church. The first part was true; once we turn 14, then we abstain. But it doesn't stop at 70 years old! I think it would be a difficult task to try to convince oneself that he or she MUST have at least one meal of meat each day, including Fridays in lent. And what is the big deal? You can have a delicious meal without meat. Vegetarians never eat meat, and they survive just fine.

The Church requires of us to live the gospel. This is really what it comes out to. Living the gospel is putting the Good News of Jesus into our lives. The Word became flesh. Jesus emptied himself of his divinity and took on our humanity to show us the way. Early Christians were first called followers of the way.

During lent, we can try more than usual to become what we could be rather than what we are. We could be better Christians, better Catholics, better husbands or wives, better sons or daughters. Lent is a time to improve and take our religion more seriously. We can come to a weekday Mass if we are not used to doing this. We can pray the rosary a couple times a week if we usually don't pray the rosary. We can stop in the side chapel on a Monday evening during Adoration and devote a half hour of quiet time with Jesus. Lots of possibilities if we think about it. Don't wait till Holy Week to decide!

LENTEN REGULATIONS

- 1. ABSTINENCE Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and ALL the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. FAST Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.
