From the Pastor

Bishop Damian Junker was appointed Bishop of Alton, IL in January of 1857 – the Quincy Diocese was erected in 1853! One of the first things this bishop did was take a trip to Germany to "recruit" Franciscans to come to his diocese. Three priests and 6 brothers were chosen from the many who volunteered to come to the missions in Illinois. The friars arrived in 1858. The German Catholics of Quincy, IL had a monstrance dedicated to the Right Rev. H.D. Junker, bishop of Alton, IL. This monstrance is travelling around the diocese from parish to parish as part of our Diocesan Year of the Eucharist 12/8/22- 12/8/23.

Our parish will host this monstrance on Monday, March 27th. We will have exposition in the morning and then adoration in church all day. We will move the Blessed Sacrament to the side chapel continuing adoration until 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday. During this day of adoration we will be having our Eucharistic Day of Prayer for Life.

Are Sundays considered Lent? This gets debated. If one is giving up something or trying to do something special for Lent, when Sunday comes is he or she free of the Lenten resolution? I think raising the question is indicative of whether or not one has the spirit of Lent.

Please keep in mind our third graders, who are preparing for the first time they will receive the sacrament of reconciliation, which will be this Saturday morning, March 18th.

At the 4:30 Mass this weekend we had what is called the First Scrutiny for those preparing to enter the Church at the Easter Vigil. Alaina Martin, the daughter of Nicholas and Ashley Martin, is going to be baptized this year. She will continue her initiation with Confirmation and her first Eucharist at a later time.

At the time of the writing of this bulletin, we just don't know the outcome of the basketball games this week. We do know what happened at Carbondale on Monday night. Congratulations to our Shoes!! We are proud of you!

LENTEN REGULATIONS

1. ABSTINENCE – Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and ALL the Fridays of Lent.

2. FAST – Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.


