

From the Pastor

A week ago we had our Hail and Farewell dinner for the incoming and outgoing members of our parish council. This past Thursday the council met, and it was the last meeting for three of our members and the first meeting for their replacements. The members leaving are Jamie Habing, Barb Weber and Clem Ruholl. The parishioners are grateful to these people for their stewardship of time. It's not just attending the meetings of the council, but each member serves on a committee like the Buildings and Grounds committee and others. People, who serve on the council, usually are glad they served and learned more about how the parish functions. The three new members the parish discerned are: Donna Addis, Dan Blankenship, and Dr. Charles Runde. The new officers will be elected at their first meeting.

Please mark March 28th on your calendars. At 7:00 on that Tuesday evening the parish will have the opportunity to receive the sacrament of Penance. We will have at least 3 priests available for confessions starting at 7:00. We normally have confessions from 6:15 to 6:45 on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. On that Tuesday evening there will NOT be confessions at 6:15. In the past I presumed people would figure this out on their own, but... Some people like to get the jump on the line. We see this at visitations and other times. This will be a good opportunity for you to prepare your heart and soul for Easter.

No one is perfect, and I am proof of that. I wrote in last week's bulletin that Alaina Martin would be baptized this Easter Vigil and receive the other sacraments of initiation later. I am wrong. She will be fully initiated at the Easter Vigil and her two younger sisters will be baptized. They will receive the other sacraments of initiation later with their classmates. Sorry about that, Alaina.

Also mark your calendar for March 27th, the day of our Eucharistic Day of Prayer for Life. We will have adoration all day, and since it is a Monday, our adoration will be extended all night until Tuesday morning at 6 o'clock. The Blessed Sacrament will be in a monstrance that was given to Bishop Henry Damien Juncker by the community in Quincy. This monstrance is moving from parish to parish in our diocese because of our diocesan Year of the Eucharist.

Did you know that the diocese of Chicago consisted of all Illinois, and Pope Pius IX erected the Diocese of Quincy in 1853? That moved to Alton, and the first bishop of Alton was a newly consecrated bishop.

Since March 19th this year is the Fourth Sunday of Lent, the feast of St. Joseph is moved to Monday, the next day. On the 20th there will be a Gloria and a Creed, white vestments instead of the Lenten violet, all celebrating the feast of the foster father of Jesus.

This Wednesday, the 22nd, I am taking the train to Chicago and having supper with a nephew I have never met! He lives in Maine and has 6 children. How does this happen? After I tell you that story, I'll share with you a story about another nephew I never met until he was in his early 20's! Two different fathers involved, both brothers. Maybe there is a homily in here somewhere!



LENTEN REGULATIONS

1. ABSTINENCE – Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and ALL the Fridays of Lent.

2. FAST – Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.

3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.


