

From the Pastor


As you know, 6 provinces of Franciscans in the United States, including our own Sacred Heart Province with headquarters in St. Louis, are combining to form one new province for the whole country. The name of the new province will be Our Lady of Guadalupe Province, and the headquarters will be Atlanta, GA. This all takes place in October of this year. What impact will this have on our parish? Will St. Francis Parish become a diocesan parish like the others in the area? No one knows the answer!

There are two meetings of the Guardians or religious superiors of the local communities for these provinces – one meeting is in Albuquerque, NM and the other is in Easton, PA. I am going to the one in PA since I will be able to visit my sister, Joanne, and her family in conjunction with that travel. They live in Buffalo. It's a long drive to Easton – like 775 miles, and I'll be leaving right after 6:30 Mass this Sunday. Please pray for a safe journey. Thank you. I'll keep you posted on any impact this change will have on the parish.

They will receive a Confirmation pin and a First Communion pin. Parishioners are encouraged to pick a name off the posters by the entrances of church to pray for them.




