From the Pastor


Tuesday is the 4th of July. Happy Independence Day to all! We will have only one Mass that morning, and that Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. Come and pray! There are certainly many intentions that we can pray for. On the day before, Monday, we will have the usual exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 1 o'clock, and then adoration will continue until 6:00 a.m. Tuesday.

You might have noticed that Fr. Dennis has been on vacation. He returns Thursday, July 6th. Fr. Juan Carlos Ruiz left for vacation on Friday, June 30th, and he will return on this Saturday, July 8th.

It has been a few years since the parish has had a census. This year will be the "year of the census." It is going to mean a good deal of work since we will have a large amount of information to deal with. If someone asks you to be involved, please respond affirmatively. I would like to see the whole parish get behind this and make it a parish endeavor. Your particular commitment will likely be short. I anticipate it being a relatively quick process of gathering the data if we all work together.
