

From the Pastor

This Wednesday is Aug 2nd, the feast of Our Lady of the Angels of the Portiuncula. It's pronounced: por-tsi-un-cu-la, which means in Italian: the little portion. If you look above the first pew in our church, at the large mural that is over our altar of sacrifice, you will see Petitionem tuam, Francisce, admitto. God is with the Blessed Mother, and Francis is kneeling at their feet with his prayer that this indulgence be granted. The Latin means: Francis, I grant your request.

Upon entering our church, immediately on your left – the east side – the first full stained glass window is very similar to the mural over the altar – it states it is the granting of the Portiuncula Indulgence. The two pieces of art are very similar.

What is required for the indulgence? Celebration of the sacrament of Penance – or going to confession – participation in the Eucharist – receiving Communion – a prayer for the intention of the Holy Father, the Creed, and praying the Lord's Prayer.

The little chapel, or little portion, was very dear to St. Francis. It's located very near Assisi, just down the hill. A very large church was built over it, so you can enter the church and then also enter the little church inside! Crowds gather in and near Assisi on this day for the indulgence.

Please mark your calendar, if you haven't already done so, for Saturday, October 28th. All the people in the diocese are invited to gather in Springfield for the Eucharistic Celebration. More details later, but we are going to need to know who is coming. Please mark your calendar and count on participating in this Eucharistic and historical event.

We congratulate our parishioner, Mark Probst, who was successful in doing the Iron Man again last Sunday. The Iron Man is not for everyone: the person must swim 3 miles, run 26 miles, and then ride a bike for 100 miles. This is the second time Mark has done this!! I'm hesitant to pick out individuals and brag on them because of the precedent: you did it for this person, why aren't you doing it for my son or daughter kind of deal. When another parishioner does the Iron Man, and I learn of it, I will be more than happy to put the name in the bulletin. It is a remarkable feat.

Our census is nearing. We really need everyone to cooperate in this endeavor. We are going to reach out first by mailing it, and I hope we can get a very good percentage to reply. Then there will be the reaching out by going to the door. If only one family or person is missing then our census is incomplete.

We met this week to discuss the location of the Mass for our parish picnic on September 16th. Mark that date down! You don't want to miss it. Pray for favorable weather!




